¹⁰ Finally, be strengthened by the Lord and by his vast strength. ¹¹ Put on the full armor of God so that you can stand against the schemes of the devil. ¹² For our struggle is not against flesh and blood, but against the rulers, against the authorities, against the cosmic powers of this darkness, against evil, spiritual forces in the heavens. ¹³ For this reason take up the full armor of God, so that you may be able to resist in the evil day, and having prepared everything, to take your stand. ¹⁴ Stand, therefore, with truth like a belt around your waist, righteousness like armor on your chest, ¹⁵ and your feet sandaled with readiness for the gospel of peace. ¹⁶ In every situation take up the shield of faith with which you can extinguish all the flaming arrows of the evil one. ¹⁷ Take the helmet of salvation and the sword of the Spirit—which is the word of God. ¹⁸ Pray at all times in the Spirit with every prayer and request, and stay alert with all perseverance and intercession for all the saints. ¹⁹ Pray also for me, that the message may be given to me when I open my mouth to make known with boldness the mystery of the gospel. ²⁰ For this I am an ambassador in chains. Pray that I might be bold enough to speak about it as I should.

Weekly Prayer:

Pray for our church-This week, we are praying that our church would take seriously our responsibility to pray for the work our missions partners are doing around the world. Pray we would be faithful to pray "that the word of the Lord may spread rapidly and be honored, just as it was with (us)" and that missionaries "may be delivered from wicked and evil people" (2 Thess. 3:1-2). Pray that we would remember and remind one another to pray individually, as families, as small groups, and as a body. Pray that missionaries would be encouraged and strengthened through our prayers.

Pray for a church-This week, we are praying for Rocky Bayou Baptist Church in Niceville. Pray for their pastor, Troy Hamilton, and His wife, Beth. Pray for their 8 elders to work in unity and effectively in shepherding their body. Pray that their sermon series through Nehemiah would grow their love and trust for the Lord, and desire to serve Him in His work.

Pray for the Church-This week, we are praying for the work of the International Mission Board. Pray for the 3,532 missionaries working among 1,632 people groups all over the world. Pray that missionaries would be cared for and discipled faithfully both by their sending churches and local churches in the field. Pray that they would seek the Lord's Word in how to go about their tasks. Pray the Lord would make the fruit of their work clear, and that they would trust Him for the growth. Pray for greater health and trust between churches and missionaries. Ultimately, pray the Lord would be glorified and His Church built through this organization and its labors.
