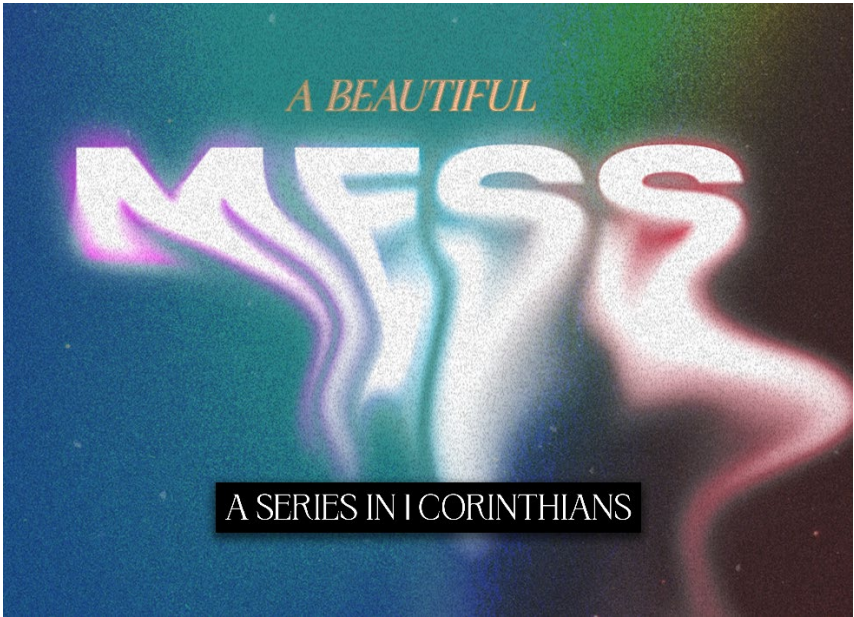

Weekly Prayer:

Pray for our church-This week we are praying Colossians 4:2 in connection with our membership covenant's commitment to pray for one another.
