Weekly Prayer:

Pray for our church-This week we pray Colossians 3:13 for one another, which calls for us to "bearing with one another and forgiving one another if anyone has a grievance against another. Just as the Lord has forgiven you, so you are also to forgive." Pray we would be quick and willing to forgive one another. Pray we would see disagreements and issues in our body as opportunities to serve the Lord, remember His Grace, and grow together. Pray the world would see our compassion for one another and look to Jesus.

Pray for a church-This week we are praying for Redeeming Grace Church in Phoenix, AZ. Pray for their pastor, Jon Deedrick, and their lay pastors, Steve and Bo. Pray as Jon preaches through the Gospel of Matthew, that the church would better understand their King and His Kingdom.

Pray for the Church-This week we are praying for the Church in Uzbekistan. While this country of 36 million people is only 0.2% Christian, Christianity is growing rapidly among the small number of Believers. Pray that they would withstand the persecution from their government and disownment from their families. Pray that both muslim and atheistic strongholds would break and that Christ would be worshipped among these people.
