Call to Worship 1 Corinthians 15:1-4,19-22 John Drummond ¹Now I want to make clear for you, brothers and sisters, the gospel I preached to you, which you received, on which you have taken your stand ²and by which you are being saved, if you hold to the message I preached to you — unless you believed in vain. ³For I passed on to you as most important what I also received: that Christ died for our sins according to the Scriptures, ⁴that he was buried, that he was raised on the third day according to the Scriptures...

Weekly Prayer:

Pray for our Church- This week we are praying 2 Timothy 4:2 For one another. It says: ²*Preach the word; be ready in season and out of season; rebuke, correct, and encourage with great patience and teaching.* Pray for Thomas as he prepares to preach each week, specifically through the book of Judges in coming weeks. Pray that we would take the Word and preach it to ourselves daily. Pray that we would be bold to preach the Gospel to one another and to those around us who may not know Christ. Pray that we would teach, encourage, and correct one another as we strive to be more faithful preachers of the Gospel.

Pray for our Region- This week, as a part of our Annie Armstrong Easter Offering focus, we are praying for the re-planting of Morningside Baptist Church in Atlanta. Pray for their pastor, Christian White, and his wife, Kimmie as they navigate a new church and growing family. Pray for God to send spiritually mature believers to share in discipling the congregation. Pray for increased health and spiritual growth in their congregation. More than anything, pray that God would be glorified through this rebirth and revitalization of this church.

Pray for our World- This week we are praying for continued Bible translation work among unreached people groups. Two billion people around the world (20%), about 6500 languages, do not have the Bible translated in their language. Pray for ongoing translation projects to be completed. Pray that Christians who are gifted in language learning would see this need and commit their lives to changing these numbers. Pray for churches to see the need and commit to fund the work. Ultimately, pray that the Lord would use the work of translating His Word to take the Gospel to the far corners of the world!
