Acts 3:24 (HCSB)

In addition, all the prophets who have spoken, from Samuel and those after him, have also announced these days.

- "Samuel was considered the first prophet after Moses
- "These days" are the days of Messianic salvation

As Sons They Should Obey

Acts 3:25 (NASB)

"It is you who are the sons of the prophets and of the covenant which God made with your fathers, saying to Abraham, 'And in your seed all the families of the earth shall be blessed."

- "Peter preaches pointedly and personally -- "YOU"
- "Genesis 12:3 is the seed promise
- In Acts 7:51-53 Stephen indicted his Jewish listeners for being sons of those who killed the prophets
- "As "sons of the prophets" they should believe Messiah

To the Jew First

Acts 3:26 (HCSB)

God raised up His Servant and sent Him first to you to bless you by turning each of you from your evil ways.

- "Repentance is a blessing from God
- ""First" does not mean "only"
- "Genesis 12:3 extends blessing to all peoples
- "Acts 1:8; Romans 1:16; Isaiah 49:6

- "The angel about JTB = Luke 1:16
- "In Acts 26:16-18 Paul is commissioned by Jesus to preach repentance
