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# The Key Texts

Acts 2:27; Romans 10:6-8; Ephesians 4:8-9; 1 Peter 3:18-20

Acts 2:25-28 ESV For David says concerning him, "I saw the Lord always before me, for he is at my right hand that I may not be shaken; 26 therefore my heart was glad, and my tongue rejoiced; my flesh also will dwell in hope. 27 For you will not abandon my soul to Hades, or let your Holy One see corruption. 28 You have made known to me the paths of life; you will make me full of gladness with your presence."

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# The Key Texts

Romans 10:6-8 ESV But the righteousness based on faith says, Do not say in your heart, Who will ascend into heaven?' (that is, to bring Christ down) 7 "or 'Who will descend into the abyss?' (that is, to bring Christ up from the dead). 8 But what does it say? "The word is near you, in your mouth and in your heart" (that is, the word of faith that we proclaim)...

The issue is not Christ being in heaven or the abyss; it is about Christ being "accessible."

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# The Key Texts

Ephesians 4:7-10 ESV But grace was given to each one of us according to the measure of Christ's gift. 8 Therefore it says, "When he ascended on high he led a host of captives, and he gave gifts to men]" 9 (In saying, "He ascended," what does it mean but that he had also descended into the lower regions, the earth? 10 He who descended is the one who also ascended far above all the heavens, that he might fill all things.)

<u>Numbers 18:6</u> Behold, I Myself have taken your fellow Levites from among the sons of Israel; they are a gift to you, dedicated to the LORD, to perform the service for the tent of meeting.

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#### The Key Texts

<u>1 Peter 3:18-20</u> For Christ also died for sins once for all, the just for the unjust, so that He might bring us to God, having been put to death in the flesh, but <u>made alive in the spirit;</u> <u>19 [in which]</u> also He went and made proclamation to the spirits now in prison, <u>20</u> who once were disobedient, when the patience of God kept waiting in the days of Noah, during the construction of the ark, in which a few, that is, eight persons, were brought safely through the water.

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#### Jesus Did Not Go to Hell After His Death

John 19:30 Therefore when Jesus had received the sour wine, He said, "It is finished!" And He bowed His head and gave up His spirit.

Luke 23:43, 46 And He said to him, "Truly I say to you, today you shall be with Me in Paradise...46 And Jesus, crying out with a loud voice, said, "Father, INTO YOUR HANDS I COMMIT MY SPIRIT." Having said this, He breathed His last.

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#### O.T. Saints Went to Heaven After Death

<u>Genesis 5:24</u> Enoch walked with God; and he was not, for God took him.

Psalm 23:6 Surely goodness and lovingkindness will follow me all the days of my life, and I will dwell in the house of the LORD forever.

Psalm 49:15 But God will redeem my soul from the power of Sheol, for He will receive me. Selah.

<u>Psalm 73:24</u> With Your counsel You will guide me, and afterward receive me to glory.

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#### O.T. Saints Went to Heaven After Death

<u>Proverbs 14:32</u> The wicked is thrust down by his wrongdoing, but the righteous has a refuge when he dies.

Ecclesiastes 12:7 then the dust will return to the earth as it was, and the spirit will return to God who gave it.

Mark 12:27 He is not the God of the dead, but of the living; you are greatly mistaken.

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# Will God Abandon the Righteous?

Genesis 15:6 Then he believed in the LORD; and He reckoned it to him as righteousness.

Romans 4:6-8 So also David speaks of the blessedness of those to whom God reckons righteousness apart from works: 7 "Blessed are those whose iniquities are forgiven, and whose sins are covered; 8 blessed is the one against whom the Lord will not reckon sin."

Psalm 116:15 Precious in the sight of the LORD Is the death of His godly ones.
