## Leprosy And The Ceremonial Law

Leviticus 13:46 He shall remain unclean all the days during which he has the infection; he is unclean. He shall live alone; his dwelling shall be outside the camp.

## The Leper's Faith

<u>Mark 1:40</u> And a leper came to Jesus, beseeching Him and falling on his knees before Him, and saying, "**If You are willing**, You can make me clean."

## Jesus Cleanses The Leper

<u>Mark 1:41-42</u> Moved with compassion, Jesus stretched out His hand and touched him, and said to him, "I am willing; **be cleansed**." Immediately the leprosy left him and he was cleansed.

<u>God</u>	Sin Stained World
Holy	Profane
Life Giving	Death
Clean ←	Unclean

### Lesson 1

#### Jesus came to "cleanse" us so that we may live with God forever.

<u>Numbers 5:2-3</u> Command the sons of Israel that they send away from the camp every leper and everyone having a discharge and everyone who is unclean because of a dead person. You shall send away both male and female; you shall send them outside the camp so that they will not defile their camp **where I** dwell in their midst.

### Sinful Man is Incompatible With God

<u>Psalm 5:4-5</u> For You are not a God who takes pleasure in wickedness; No evil dwells with You. The boastful shall not stand before Your eyes; You hate all who do iniquity.

<u>Revelation 21:27</u>...and nothing unclean, and no one who practices abomination and lying, shall ever come into it, but only those whose names are written in the Lamb's book of life.

### Jesus Makes His People Clean Forever

John 13:10 Jesus said to him, "He who has bathed needs only to wash his feet, but is completely clean; and you are clean, but not all of you."

John 15:3 You are already clean because of the word which I have spoken to you.

<u>Hebrews 10:14</u> For by one offering He has perfected for all time those who are sanctified.

### The Leper's Healing Is A "Testimony"

<u>Mark 1:43-44</u> And **He sternly warned** him and immediately sent him away, and He said to him, "See that you say nothing to anyone; but go, show yourself to the priest and offer for your cleansing what Moses commanded, as a testimony to them."

Better rendered = "as a testimony *against* them" (cf. Mark 6:11; 13:9)

## Jesus' Popularity Spreads

<u>Mark 1:45</u> But he went out and began to proclaim it freely and to spread the news around, to such an extent that Jesus could no longer publicly enter a city, but stayed out in unpopulated areas; and they were coming to Him from everywhere.

### Lesson 2: Jesus "Fulfills" The Law

>How do we understand Jesus' fulfilling of the entire law (Matt. 5:17) while touching the leper in Mark 1:41?

<u>Numbers 19:22</u> Furthermore, anything that the unclean person touches shall be unclean; and the person who touches it shall be unclean until evening' (cf. Leviticus 13-14).

### Different Aspects Of The Law

**Moral** = Eternal based on God's character **Civil** = Temporary illustrations **Ceremonial** = Temporary illustrations

<u>1 Samuel 15:22</u> Samuel said, "Has the Lord as much delight in burnt offerings and sacrifices As in obeying the voice of the Lord? Behold, **to obey is better than sacrifice**, And to heed than the fat of rams.

# The "Weightier" Matters of The Law

<u>Matthew 23:23</u> Woe to you, scribes and Pharisees, hypocrites! For you tithe mint and dill and cummin, and have neglected the weightier provisions of the law: justice and mercy and faithfulness; but these are the things you should have done without neglecting the others.

### The Law Points To Christ

Exodus 25:40 See that you make them after the pattern for them, which was shown to you on the mountain.

<u>Hebrews 10:1</u> For the Law, since it has only a shadow of the good things to come and **not the very form of things**, can never, by the same sacrifices which they offer continually year by year, make perfect those who draw near.

## Will you stand firm in the gospel?

<u>Romans 10:4</u> For Christ is the end of the law for righteousness to everyone who believes.

<u>Colossians 2:16-17</u> Therefore no one is to act as your judge in regard to food or drink or in respect to a festival or a new moon or a Sabbath day-things which are a mere shadow of what is to come; but **the substance belongs to Christ.**
