What Do We Learn Form This?
>The fact that Jesus is the Son of Man who can heal the lame means the last days

have come upon us.

Then the eyes of the blind will be opened and the ears of the deaf will be unstopped. Then the lame will leap like a deer, and the tongue of the mute will shout for joy...(Matthew 11:5).

What Do We Learn Form This?

> Those who trust in Jesus will one day be healed "completely."

Psalm 103:2-3 Bless the Lord, O my soul, and forget none of His benefits; Who pardons all your iniquities, Who heals all your diseases...
