Later Phase of Galilean Ministry

Mark 3:7- Jesus withdraws with disciples. Mark 6:13 - Jesus sends the disciples out.

The Pharisees Plot Against Jesus

Mark 3:1-2 He entered again into a synagogue; and a man was there whose hand was withered. They were watching Him to see if He would heal him on the Sabbath, so that they might accuse Him.

Jesus Puts Them In A Dilemma

Mark 3:3-4 He said to the man with the withered hand, "Get up and come forward!" And He said to them, "Is it lawful to do good or to do harm on the Sabbath, to save a life or to kill?" But they kept silent.

Jesus Puts Them In A Dilemma "To Work" To do good? To do harm? Or To save a life? Jesus vs. 5 To kill? Pharisees vs. 6

How Would You Want To Be Treated?

Mark 12:29-31 Jesus answered, "The foremost is, 'Hear, O Israel! The Lord our God is one Lord; and you shall love the Lord your God with all your heart, and with all your soul, and with all your mind, and with all your strength.' "The second is this, 'You shall love your neighbor as yourself.' There is no other commandment greater than these."

Do We Neglect The Weightier Matters? Matthew 23:23 "Woe to you, scribes and Pharisees, hypocrites! For you tithe mint and dill and cummin, and have neglected the weightier provisions of the law: justice and mercy and faithfulness; but these are the things you should have done without neglecting the others."	
Jesus Grieves Over Their Hard Hearts Mark 3:5-6 After looking around at them with anger, grieved at their hardness of heart, He said to the man, "Stretch out your hand." And he stretched it out, and his hand was restored. The Pharisees went out and immediately began conspiring with the Herodians against Him, as to how they might destroy Him.	
God Hardened Their Hearts Romans 9:18 So then He has mercy on whom He desires, and He hardens whom He desires. Romans 11:7 What then? What Israel is seeking, it has not obtained, but those who were chosen obtained it, and the rest were hardened. Romans 11:25ba partial hardening has happened to Israel until the fullness of the Gentiles has come in.
