# **Prayer Addressed to the Creator**

### Acts 4:23, 24 (HCSB)

After they were released, they went to their own people and reported everything the chief priests and the elders had said to them. When they heard this, they all raised their voices to God and said, "Master, You are the One who made the heaven, the earth, and the sea, and everything in them."

<sup>"</sup> They cite God as the sovereign Creator in their prayer "They knew that having access in prayer to the Creator of the universe, they could certainly withstand the threats of the Jewish leadership

# **Theology Informed Their Prayer**

### Acts 4:27, 28 (HCSB)

- For, in fact, in this city both Herod and Pontius Pilate, with the Gentiles and the people of Israel, assembled together against Your holy Servant Jesus, whom You anointed, to do whatever Your hand and Your plan had predestined to take place.
- <sup>77</sup> Psalm 2:1, 2 is fulfilled as the kings of the earth and Jewish leadership conspire to kill Messiah
- " The terms boule\_ and proorizo\_ are used to denote God's predetermined purpose

## They Ask for Boldness Not Deliverance

### Acts 4:29 (HCSB)

And now, Lord, consider their threats, and grant that Your slaves may speak Your message with complete boldness,

- " Boldness is thematic in this section
- " They were determined to preach God's word no matter what
- God already knew of the threats, but they appeal for boldness based on those threats
- <sup>7</sup> See Isaiah 37:14-20

### **They Are Given Boldness**

### Acts 4:30, 31 (ESV)

"while You stretch out Your hand for healing, signs, and wonders to be performed through the name of Your holy Servant Jesus." When they had prayed, the place where they were assembled was shaken, and they were all filled with the Holy Spirit and began to speak God's message with boldness.

- " See Exodus 19:18
- <sup>"</sup> The filling of the Holy Spirit produced boldness to preach the gospel

### **Paul Wants Prayer for Boldness**

#### Ephesians 6:19, 20 (HCSB)

Pray also for me, that the message may be given to me when I open my mouth to make known with boldness the mystery of the gospel. For this I am an ambassador in chains. Pray that I might be bold enough in Him to speak as I should.

<sup>"</sup> The forces of darkness and the whole world are arrayed against the gospel, thus we must pray for boldness because we must preach it

## **Come With Boldness to The Throne**

#### Hebrews 4:16 (HCSB)

Therefore let us approach the throne of grace with boldness, so that we may receive mercy and find grace to help us at the proper time.

- " It is because of the ministry of our great High Priest that we can have such boldness
- " "proper time" can be translated "timely help"
- <sup>7</sup> Such boldness comes from understanding that our merciful High Priest "ever lives" to make intercession for us: Hebrews 7:25
