

## *“Remember” and “Do Not Forget” Bible Verses*

EXO 13:3 Moses said to the people, “**Remember** this day in which you went out from Egypt, from the house of slavery; for by a powerful hand the Lord brought you out from this place. And nothing leavened shall be eaten.”

NUM 15:39 It shall be a tassel for you to look at and **remember** all the commandments of the Lord, so as to do them and not follow after your own heart and your own eyes, after which you played the harlot,

NUM 15:40 so that you may **remember** to do all My commandments and be holy to your God.

DEU 4:10 **Remember** the day you stood before the Lord your God at Horeb, when the Lord said to me, 'Assemble the people to Me, that I may let them hear My words so they may learn to fear Me all the days they live on the earth, and that they may teach their children.'

DEU 5:15 And you shall **remember** that you were a slave in the land of Egypt, and the Lord your God brought you out of there by a mighty hand and by an outstretched arm; therefore the Lord your God commanded you to observe the sabbath day.

DEU 7:18 you shall not be afraid of them; **you shall well remember** what the Lord your God did to Pharaoh and to all Egypt:

DEU 8:2 And **you shall remember** all the way which the Lord your God has led you in the wilderness these forty years, that He might humble you, testing you, to know what was in your heart, whether you would keep His commandments or not.

DEU 8:14 then your heart will become proud and you will **forget** the Lord your God who brought you out from the land of Egypt, out of the house of slavery.

DEU 8:18 But **you shall remember** the Lord your God, for it is He who is giving you power to make wealth, that He may confirm His covenant which He swore to your fathers, as it is this day.

DEU 9:7 **Remember, do not forget how you provoked the Lord** your God to wrath in the wilderness; from the day that you left the land of Egypt until you arrived at this place, you have been rebellious against the Lord.

DEU 9:27 Remember Thy servants, Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob; do not look at the stubbornness of this people or at their wickedness or their sin.

DEU 15:15 And **you shall remember** that you were a slave in the land of Egypt, and the Lord your God redeemed you; therefore I command you this today.

DEU 16:3 You shall not eat leavened bread with it; seven days you shall eat with it unleavened bread, the bread of affliction (for you came out of the land of Egypt in haste), in order that **you may remember all the days of your life** the day when you came out of the land of Egypt.

DEU 16:12 And **you shall remember** that you were a slave in Egypt, and you shall be careful to observe these statutes.

DEU 24:9 **Remember what the Lord your God did to Miriam** on the way as you came out of Egypt.

DEU 24:18 But **you shall remember** that you were a slave in Egypt, and that the Lord your God redeemed you from there; therefore I am commanding you to do this thing.

DEU 24:22 And **you shall remember** that you were a slave in the land of Egypt; therefore I am commanding you to do this thing.

DEU 25:17 **Remember** what Amalek did to you along the way when you came out from Egypt,

DEU 32:7 **Remember the days of old**, Consider the years of all generations. Ask your father, and he will inform you, Your elders, and they will tell you.

JOS 1:13 **Remember the word** which Moses the servant of the Lord commanded you, saying, 'The Lord your God gives you rest and will give you this land.'

JDG 8:33 Then it came about, as soon as Gideon was dead, that the sons of Israel again played the harlot with the Baals, and made Baal-berith their god.

JDG 8:34 Thus the sons of Israel **did not remember** the Lord their God, who had delivered them from the hands of all their enemies on every side;

NEH 9:17 They refused to listen, And **did not remember** Your wondrous deeds which You had performed among them; So they became stubborn and appointed a leader to return to their slavery in Egypt. But You are a God of forgiveness, Gracious and compassionate, Slow to anger and abounding in lovingkindness; And You did not forsake them.

PSA 78:42 **They did not remember** His power, The day when He redeemed them from the adversary,

ISA 17:10 For **you have forgotten** the God of your salvation And have not remembered the rock of your refuge. Therefore you plant delightful plants And set them with vine slips of a strange god.

ISA 46:8 **Remember this**, and be assured; Recall it to mind, you transgressors.

ISA 46:9 **Remember the former things long past**, For I am God, and there is no other; I am God, and there is no one like Me,

ISA 51:13 That **you have forgotten** the Lord your Maker, Who stretched out the heavens And laid the foundations of the earth, That you fear continually all day long because of the fury of the oppressor, As he makes ready to destroy? But where is the fury of the oppressor?

JER 18:15 **For My people have forgotten Me**, They burn incense to worthless gods And they have stumbled from their ways, From the ancient paths, To walk in bypaths, Not on a highway,

MAT 26:75 And Peter **remembered** the word which Jesus had said, “Before a rooster crows, you will deny Me three times.” And he went out and wept bitterly.

LUK 17:32 **Remember** Lot's wife.

JOH 15:20 **Remember** the word that I said to you, 'A slave is not greater than his master.' If they persecuted Me, they will also persecute you; if they kept My word, they will keep yours also.

JOH 12:16 These things His disciples did not understand at the first; but when Jesus was glorified, then they **remembered** that these things were written of Him, and that they had done these things to Him.

ACT 11:16 And I **remembered** the word of the Lord, how He used to say, 'John baptized with water, but you will be baptized with the Holy Spirit.'

EPH 2:11 Therefore **remember** that formerly you, the Gentiles in the flesh, who are called “Uncircumcision” by the so-called “Circumcision,” which is performed in the flesh by human hands

EPH 2:12 **remember** that you were at that time separate from Christ, excluded from the commonwealth of Israel, and strangers to the covenants of promise, having no hope and without God in the world.

EPH 2:13 But now in Christ Jesus you who formerly were far off have been brought near by the blood of Christ.

HEB 10:32 But **remember the former days**, when, after being enlightened, you endured a great conflict of sufferings,

2PE 1:9 For he who lacks these qualities is blind or short-sighted, **having forgotten** his purification from his former sins.

2PE 1:12 Therefore, I will always be ready to **remind** you of these things, even though you already know them, and have been established in the truth which is present with you.

2PE 1:13 I consider it right, as long as I am in this earthly dwelling, **to stir you up by way of reminder**,

ROM 15:14 And concerning you, my brethren, I myself also am convinced that you yourselves are full of goodness, filled with all knowledge and able also to admonish one another.

ROM 15:15 But I have written very boldly to you on some points so as **to remind you** again, because of the grace that was given me from God,

2TI 2:14 **Remind them of these things**, and solemnly charge them in the presence of God not to wrangle about words, which is useless and leads to the ruin of the hearers.

2TI 2:15 Be diligent to present yourself approved to God as a workman who does not need to be ashamed, accurately handling the word of truth.

REV 2:5 Therefore **remember from where you have fallen**, and repent and do the deeds you did at first; or else I am coming to you and will remove your lampstand out of its place unless you repent.

REV 3:3 So **remember what you have received** and heard; and keep it, and repent. Therefore if you do not wake up, I will come like a thief, and you will not know at what hour I will come to you.
