<u>Mark 11:15-16</u> Then they came to Jerusalem. The Fruitlessness of Israel

<u>Mark 11:19-20</u> When evening came, they would go out of the city. As they were passing by in the morning, they saw the fig tree withered from the roots up.

<u>Isaiah 5:24</u> Therefore, as a tongue of fire consumes stubble and dry grass collapses into the flame, So their root will become like rot and their blossom blow away as dust; for they have rejected the law of the LORD of hosts and despised the word of the Holy One of Israel.
