# The Gospel as the Word of Truth

# Colossians 1:5b (NASB)

 $\ldots$  of which you previously heard in the word of truth, the gospel

- This means that the "word of truth" IS the gospel
- See John 17:17, 19

# The Gospel Bears Fruit Everywhere

#### Colossians 1:6a (NASB)

Gospel Fruit: Colossians 1:5b-8

which has come to you, just as in all the world also it is constantly bearing fruit and increasing, . . .

- Bearing fruit and growing are of the very essence and nature of the gospel
- The gospel advances both spiritually and geographically



# The Gospel Graciously Works in Believers

#### Colossians 1:6b (NASB)

even as it has been doing in you also since the day you heard of it and <u>understood</u> the grace of God in truth;

- The gospel works dynamically in the Christian
- Many "hear" externally but not all hearers "comprehend" (*epigino\_sko\_*) or "fully know"
- The gospel of truth is the gospel of grace
- The gospel is both true and has life changing power

## Faithful Epaphras Brought Them the Gospel

#### Colossians 1:7 (NASB)

just as you learned it from Epaphras, our beloved fellow bond-servant, who is a faithful servant of Christ on our behalf,

- Epaphras was from Colossae and likely heard the gospel in Ephesus from Paul
- God uses people who know and love the gospel to spread the gospel
- "learned" manthano\_ likely implies systematic instruction

#### Colossians 1:8 (NASB)

and he also informed us of your love in the Spirit.

- Love characterizes believers and is revealed in the gospel
- The Holy Spirit fills us with God's love

# Implications and Applications

- Truth is both revealed through the gospel and an essential attribute of the gospel
- God can and does use individual Christians to spread the gospel and build His church
- The ideas "bearing fruit" and "growing" show the dynamic aspect of the gospel of grace

#### Acts 16:14, 40 (NASB)

pel Fruit: Colossians 1:5b-8

A woman named Lydia, from the city of Thyatira, a seller of purple fabrics, a worshiper of God, was listening; and the Lord opened her heart to respond to the things spoken by Paul. ... They went out of the prison and entered the house of Lydia, and when they saw the brethren, they encouraged them and departed.
