

The Significance of "Peri De"

Mark 13:32 ESV But concerning that day or that hour, no one knows, not even the angels in heaven, nor the Son, but only the Father.

Peri de = %Now concerning+

The Suddenness of the 70th Week

Mark 13:35-36 % herefore, be on the alertofor you do not know when the master of the house is coming, whether in the evening, at midnight, or when the rooster crows, or in the morning 36 in case he should come suddenly and find you asleep.

- 1. % of the Lord+(1 Thess. 5:2; 2 Thess. 2:2)
- 2. %Rarousia+(Matt. 24:37; 2 Thess. 2:1))
- 3. % Waribulation+ (Matt.24:29; Mark 13:24)
- 4. %Days of the Son of Man+(Luke 17:22, 26)
- 5. %Hour of trial+(Revelation 3:10)

The Suddenness of The 70th Week

Matthew 24:37-39 For the coming of the Son of Man will be just like the days of Noah. 38 % or as in those days before the flood they were eating and drinking, marrying and giving in marriage, until the day that Noah entered the ark, 39 and they knew nothing until the flood came and swept them all away, so too will be the coming of the Son of Man.

1 Thess. 5:2-3 For you yourselves know full well that the day of the Lord will come just like a thief in the night. 3 While they are saying, Reace and safety!+ then destruction will come upon them suddenly like labor pains upon a woman with child, and they will not escape.

Luke 17:26-30 And just as it happened in the days of Noah, so it will be also in the days of the Son of Man: 27 they were eating, they were drinking, they were marrying, they were being given in marriage, until the day that Noah entered the ark, and the flood came and destroyed them all. 28 % was the same as happened in the days of Lot: they were eating, they were drinking, they were buying, they were selling, they were planting, they were building; 29 but on the day that Lot went out from Sodom it rained fire and brimstone from heaven and destroyed them all. 30 % will be just the same on the day that the Son of Man is revealed.

Good News: God's People Are Exempt

Isaiah 26:16-17, 19-21 O LORD, they sought You in distress; they could only whisper a prayer, Your chastening was upon them. 17 As the pregnant woman approaches the time to give birth, she writhes and cries out in her labor pains, thus were we before You, O LORDÕ 19 Your dead will live; their corpses will rise. You who lie in the dust, awake and shout for joy, for your dew is as the dew of the dawn, and the earth will give birth to the departed spirits. 20 Come, my people, enter into your rooms and close your doors behind you; hide for a little while until indignation runs its course. 21 For behold, the LORD is about to come out from His place to punish the inhabitants of the earth for their iniquity; and the earth will reveal her bloodshed and will no longer cover her slain.
