Jesus' Promises Are Certain

Mark 13:30-31 Truly I say to you, this generation will not pass away until all these things take place. 31 Heaven and earth will pass away, but My words will not pass away.

X Preterist = %bis generation+generation of people alive during Jesusqday.

- 2. **Futurist** = %bis generation+generation of people alive during the future 70^{th} week.
- 3 Pejorative = % bis generation+ is about a quality of people (unbelieving) which characterizes this age.

"This Generation" as a Quality Not a Quantity

<u>Deuteronomy 32:5 They have</u> acted corruptly toward Him, they are not His children because of their defect; but are a perverse and crooked generation.

Mark 9:19 And He answered them and said, ‰ unbelieving generation, how long shall I be with you? How long shall I put up with you? Bring him to Me!+

Philippians 2:15 prove yourselves to be blameless and innocent, children of God above reproach in the midst of a crooked and perverse generation, among whom you appear as lights in the worldo

<u>Mark 13:8b</u> These things are merely the beginning of birth pangs.

Current Age:
Unrighteous
Generation

Messianic Age: Righteous Generation

<u>Daniel 9:24</u> Seventy weeks have been decreed for your people and your holy city, to finish the transgression, to make an end of sin, to make atonement for iniquity, to bring in everlasting righteousness, to seal up vision and prophecy and to anoint the most holy place.

Learning to Wait for Messianic Salvation

Isaiah 40:30-31 Though youths grow weary and tired, and vigorous young men stumble badly, 31 yet those who wait for the LORD will gain new strength; they will mount up with wings like eagles, they will run and not get tired, they will walk and not become weary.

Isaiah 51:5 My righteousness is near, My salvation has gone forth, and My arms will judge the peoples; the coastlands will wait for Me, and for My arm they will wait expectantly.

Live by Faith Not by Sight

<u>Habakkuk 2:3-4</u> For the vision is yet for the appointed time; It hastens toward the goal and it will not fail. Though it tarries, wait for it; for it will certainly come, it will not delay. <u>4</u> Behold, as for the proud one, his soul is not right within him; but the righteous will live by his faith.

Romans 8:24-25 For in hope we have been saved, but hope that is seen is not hope; for who hopes for what he already sees? 25 But if we hope for what we do not see, with perseverance we wait eagerly for it.



Be Patient and Do Not Complain

James 5:7-9 Therefore be patient, brethren, until the coming of the Lord. The farmer waits for the precious produce of the soil, being patient about it, until it gets the early and late rains. 8 You too be patient; strengthen your hearts, for the coming of the Lord is near. 9 Do not complain, brethren, against one another, so that you yourselves may not be judged; behold, the Judge is standing right at the door.
