No One Knows When

Mark 13:32 ESV But concerning that day or that hour, no one knows, not even the angels in heaven, nor the Son, but only the Father.

We Should Be on the Alert

Mark 13:33-37 Take heed, keep on the alert; for you do not know when the **appointed time** will come. 34 % is like a man away on a journey, who upon leaving his house and putting his slaves in charge, assigning to each one his task, also commanded the doorkeeper to stay on the alert. 35 Therefore, be on the alert for you do not know when the master of the house is coming, whether in the evening, at midnight, or when the rooster crows, or in the morning 36 in case he should come suddenly and find you asleep. 37 What I say to you I say to all, Be on the alert!

- 1. We should remember that there will be no warning prior to the parousia of Christ.+

1. There Is No Warning Except God's Word

Matthew 24:43 But be sure of this, that if the head of the house had known at what time of the night the thief was coming, he would have been on the alerto

1 Thessalonians 5:2 For you yourselves know full well that the day of the Lord will come just like a thief in the night.

2 Peter 3:10 But the day of the Lord will come like a thiefo

Thief = lestes (uses force), kleptes (uses stealth)

> Subsequent Work
