Mark 14:29-31 But Peter said to Him, ‰ven though all may fall away, yet I will not.+ 30 And Jesus said to him, ‰ruly I say to you, that this very night, before a rooster crows twice, you yourself will deny Me three times.+ 31 But Peter kept saying insistently, ‰ven if I have to die with You, I will not deny You!+And they all were saying the same thing also.

2. We Should Avoid Boastful Talk

James 4:13-16 Come now, you who say, Wooday or tomorrow we will go to such and such a city, and spend a year there and engage in business and make a profit.+ 14 Yet you do not know what your life will be like tomorrow. You are just a vapor that appears for a little while and then vanishes away. 15 Instead, you ought to say, What he Lord wills, we will live and also do this or that.+ 16 But as it is, you boast in your arrogance; all such boasting is evil.
