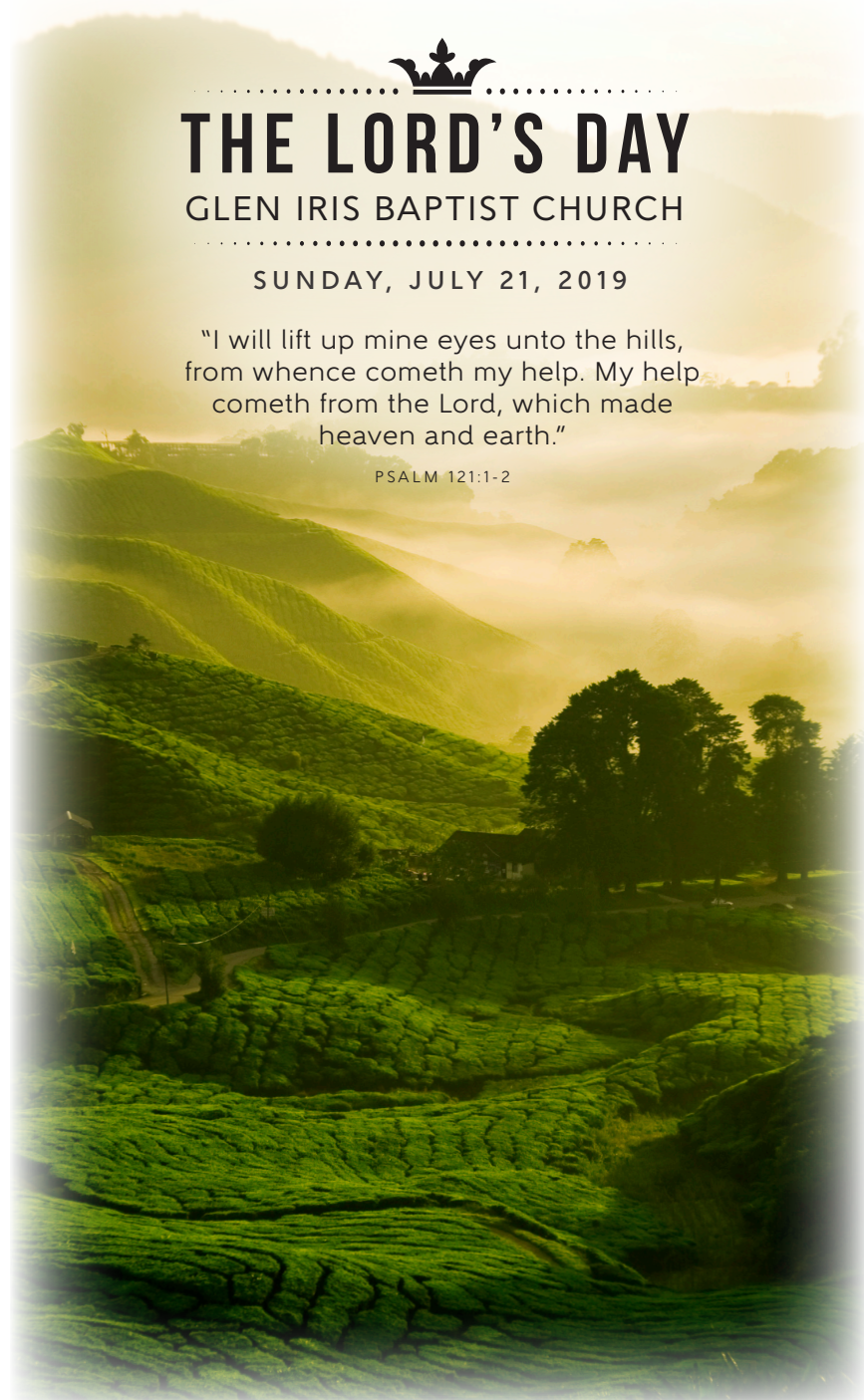

A BAPTIST CATECHISM

Question 113:

What do we pray for in the second petition of the Lord's Prayer?

Answer:

In the second petition, which is, "Thy kingdom come," we pray that Satan's kingdom may be destroyed and that the kingdom of grace may be advanced; that ourselves and others be brought into it and kept in it; and that the kingdom of glory may be hastened.
