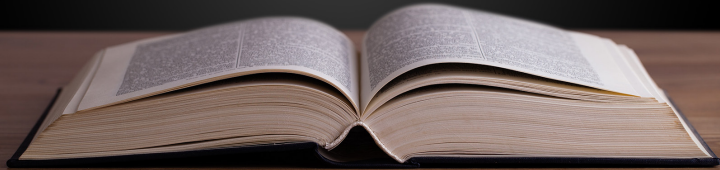


# Are you in a Bible Class Sunday Mornings?
