NEW MEMBERS

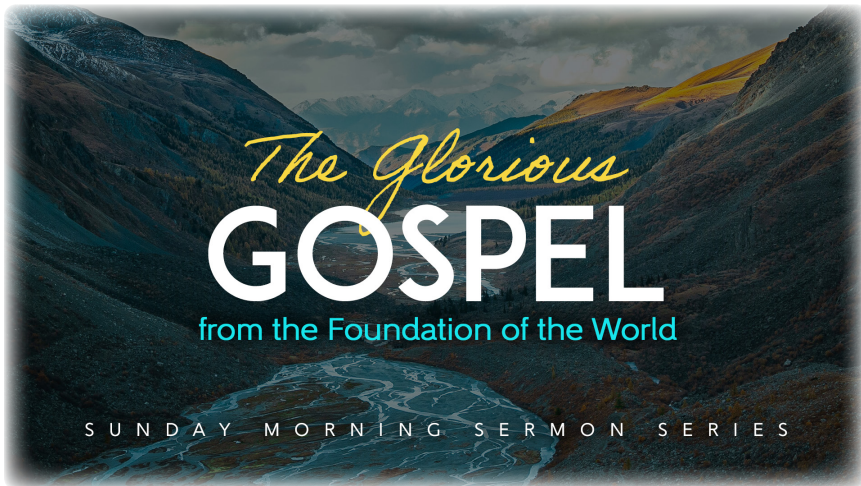
