**To date, we have approximately \$53k of the \$95k raised.**



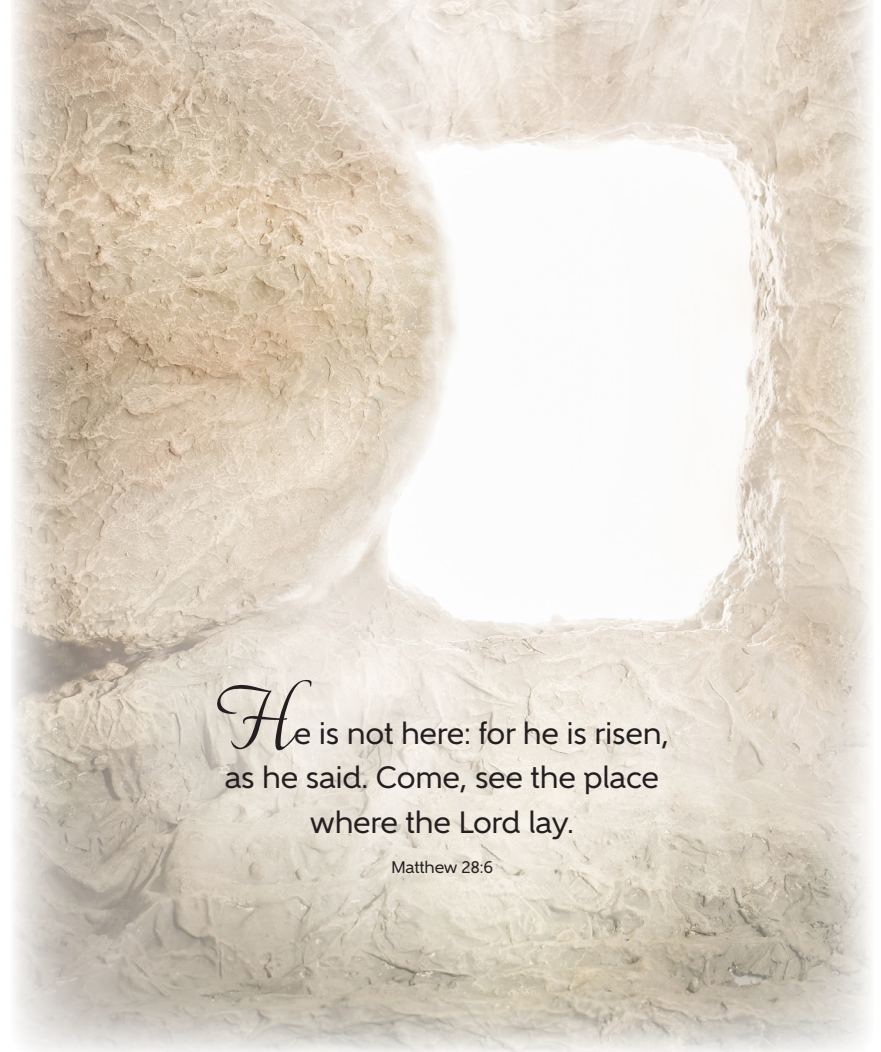
