SUNDAY SCHOOL

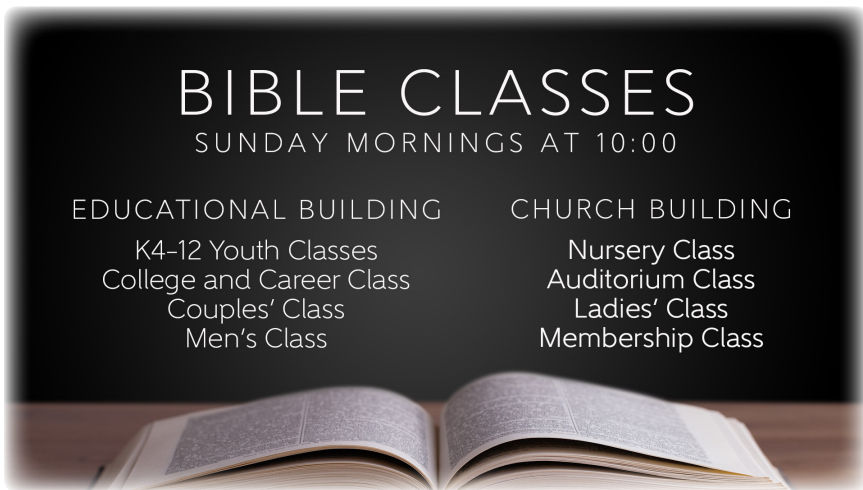
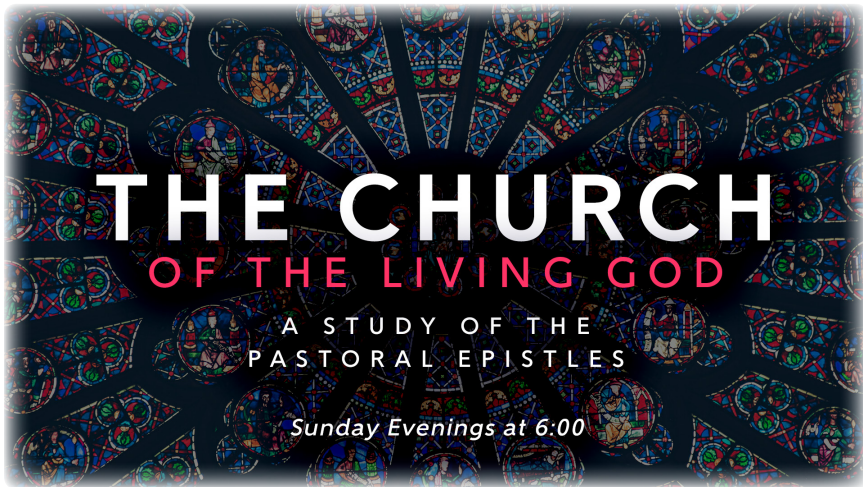
