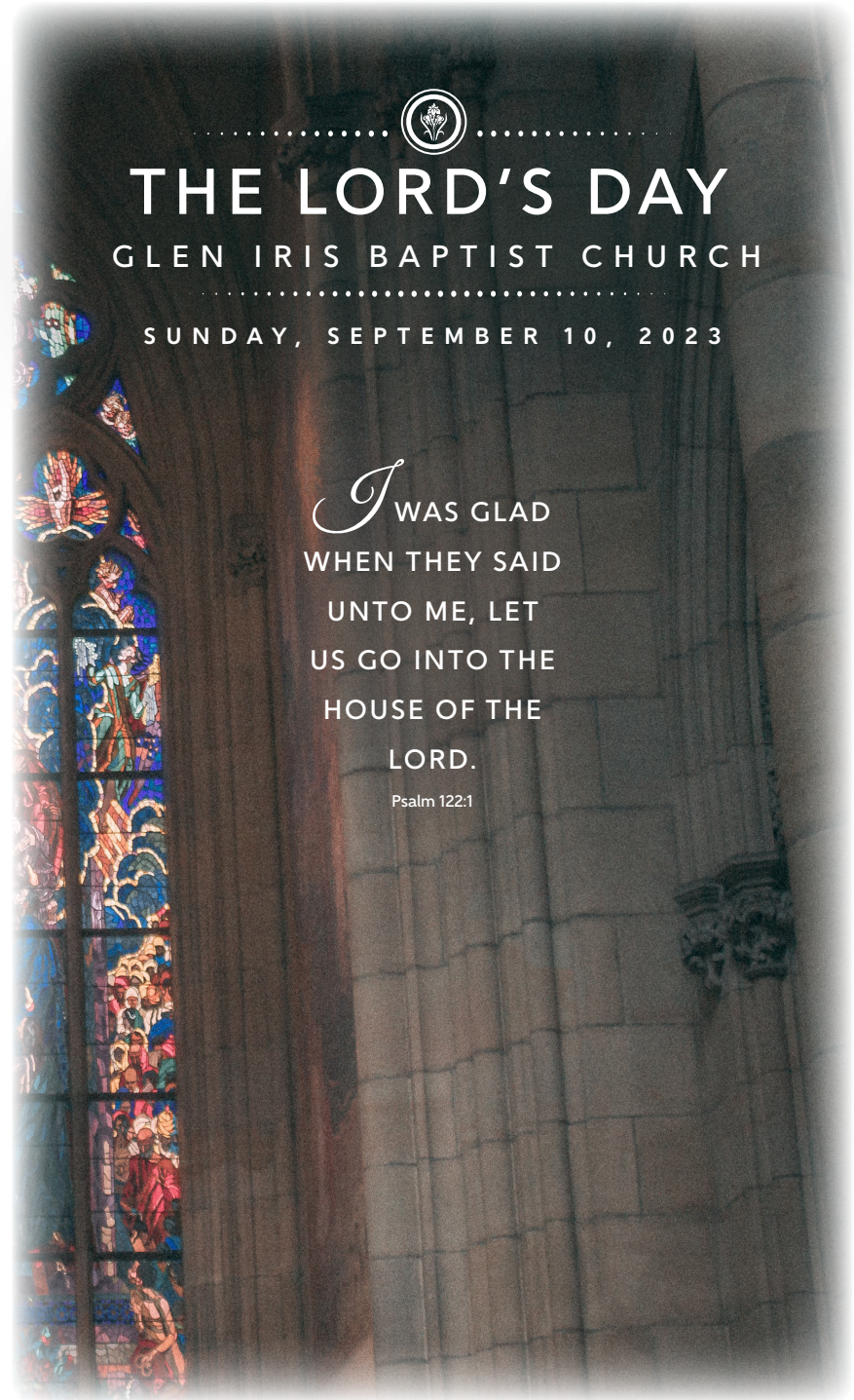

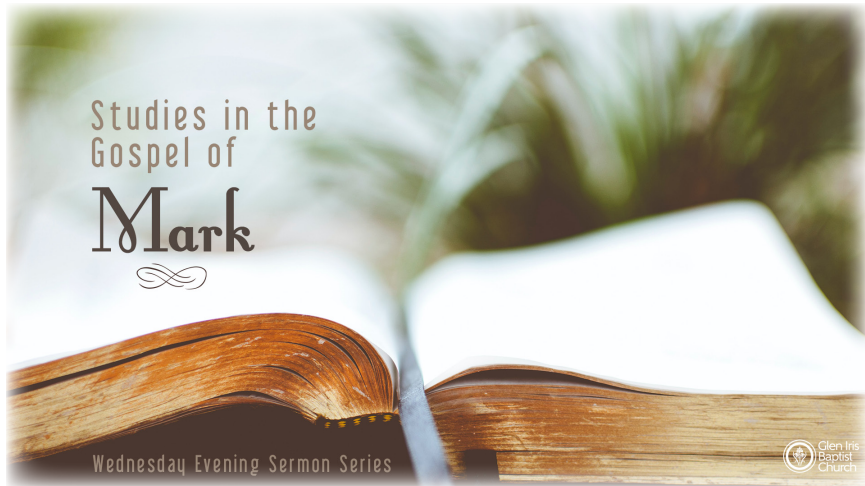
### SUNDAY MORNING & EVENING SERVICES
