



AUDITORIUM WINDOWS

After 73 years and some refurbishing along the way, the stained-glass windows in the auditorium are in dire need of complete restoration soon. The exterior shows much rot and decay, leaving the windows in a very fragile state. We have received several estimates, all of which are very costly.
