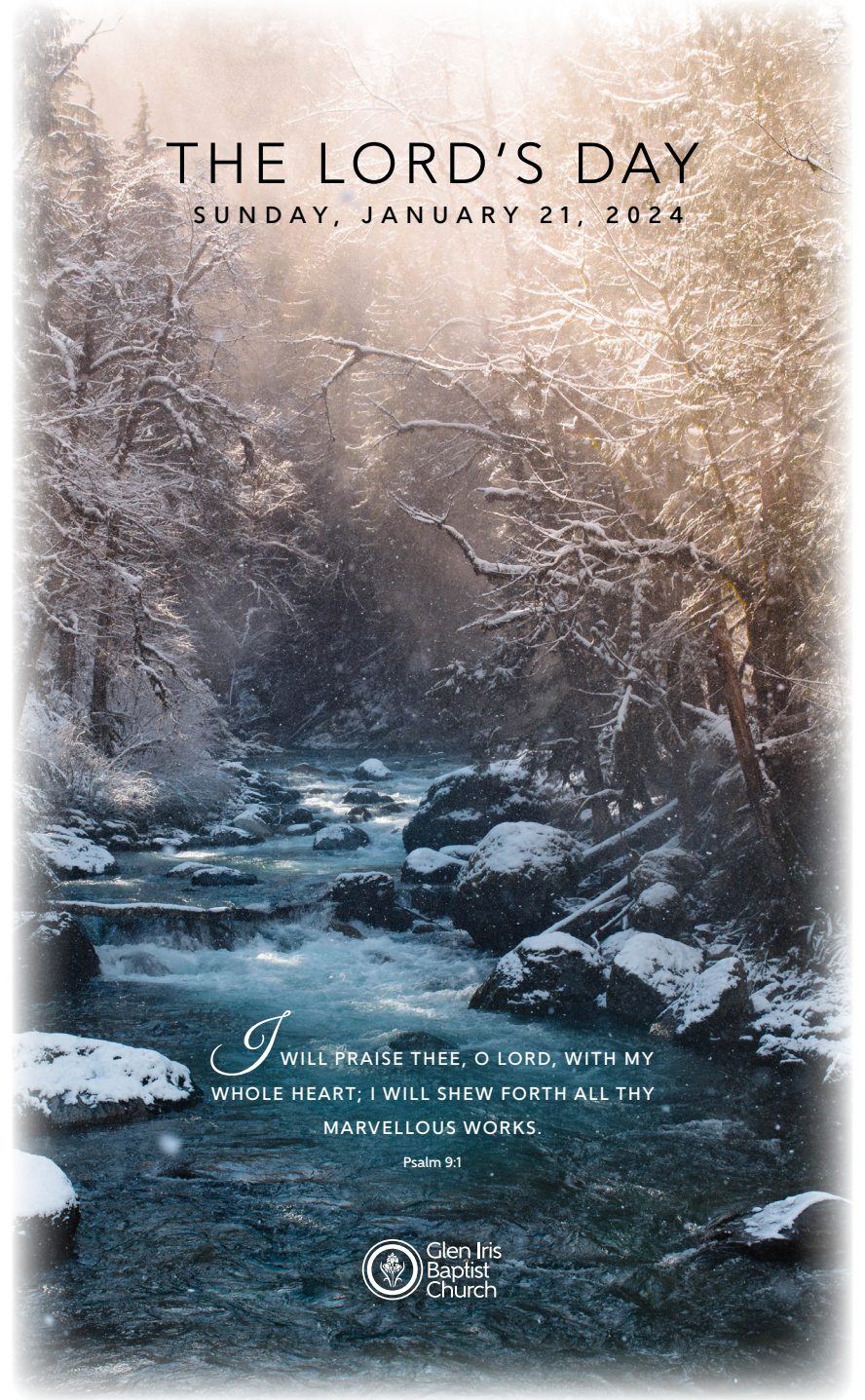
## AUDITORIUM WINDOWS






