

Commencement Sunday

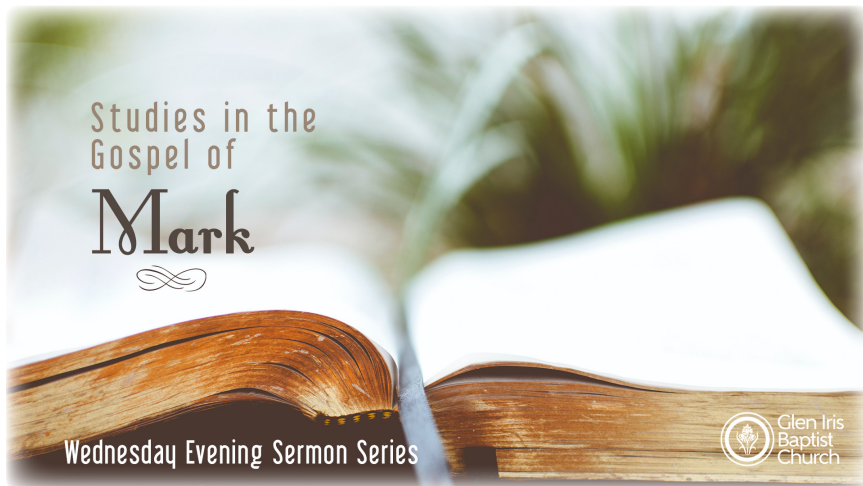
