Our Lord appeared after His resurrection to many different people at various times. One of the most interesting of these sightings is recorded in Luke 23. Two of His disciples were travelling from Jerusalem to a village called Emmaus, some seven and a half miles. On their way, they discussed the recent events concerning Jesus. They were disappointed and disillusioned. They confessed that they had believed Him to be the promised Messiah who would deliver Israel from Roman occupation and that He would establish His kingdom. Neither of these things materialized. It was the third day and nothing had happened—or so they thought.

A stranger joined them on their journey. How touching that Jesus took the time to minister to these men. Our Lord is a personal Savior, interested in us individually.

Interestingly, Luke gives us the name of one of these disciples. His name was Cleophas. When comparing the Gospel records, we learn in John 19:25, "Now there stood by the cross of Jesus His mother, and His mother's sister, Mary the wife of Cleophas, and Mary Magdalene." Cleophas, then, was the brother-in-law of Mary, Jesus' mother. He appears to be the more vocal of the two. He tells what has gone on the last few days, that Jesus was crucified and reported to have risen from the grave. They had not personally witnessed the resurrected Christ.

Jesus answers them from the Word of God. He reminds them that the prophets foretold that Messiah must suffer and die for the sins of His people before entering into His glory and establishing His kingdom. "And beginning at Moses and all the prophets, He expounded unto them in all the Scriptures the things concerning Himself." [Luke 24:27] We learn several lessons from this portion of Scripture.

First, doubting the Word of God brings depression and discouragement. Everything God has spoken will come to pass. Jesus said, "For verily I say unto you, till heaven and earth pass, one jot or one tittle shall in no wise pass from the law, till all be fulfilled." [Matthew 5:16] The prophets had

foretold these events, and they came to pass just as they predicted.

Second, notice Jesus' method of teaching. "...He expounded unto them in all the Scriptures." *Expound* in the Greek means to thoroughly explain, to translate, to interpret. This is how the faithful Bible teacher is to handle the Word of God. We are not to attempt to entertain, or to tell what we think, or to impress our audience. We are to thoroughly explain the Scripture so that our audience can understand what it teaches. This requires much study and prayer. The Holy Spirit of God inspired the writers to record God's Word, and His ministry is to reveal its truths to us.

Third, the Bible is His Book. All of it, from Genesis to Revelation points to the Person and Work of Jesus Christ—who He was and is, and what He came to do. The whole Bible is the revelation of Jesus Christ. He is the "Word made flesh who dwelt among us." [John 1:14] It is the Holy Spirit's ministry to open our eyes to the truths concerning Christ and His work. [vs. 31] When we lift Him up, when He is exalted in our teaching and preaching, when He is explained and honored, the result will be amazing. These disciples confessed, "Did not our heart burn within us, while He talked with us by the way, and while He opened to us the Scriptures?" [vs. 32] May all we who handle the Word of God do it in just this way. The songwriter put it this way:

I am Thine O Lord; I have heard Thy voice,
And it told Thy love to me.
But I long to rise in the arms of faith,
And be closer drawn to Thee.
Draw me nearer, nearer blessed Lord,
To the cross where Thou hast died—
Draw me nearer, nearer, nearer blessed Lord
To Thy precious bleeding side.
