Who may come to the Lord's Table?

- 1) Have you been baptized in the name of the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit?
- 2) Have you publicly professed your faith in Jesus Christ, and do you embrace the Christian faith as summarized in the Apostles' Creed?
- 3) Are you presently a member in good standing of a Bible-believing, gospel-preaching church?

If you can affirm these questions sincerely, the elders welcome you to the Lord's Table! But if you have any hesitation at all, then we would encourage you to refrain from taking the Lord's Supper today. Reflect on the preached Word, Pray for God draw you closer to the Lord Jesus Christ, and come talk to the pastor or an elder.

How do I learn more about joining the church?

The Pastor offers membership classes periodically. This class introduces interested visitors to the beliefs of our church and life together in this church family. Please contact Pastor Jud if you are interested in attending a class.

The Nursery & Training Room

We do not have a staffed nursery or separate children's ministry. Instead, we welcome your children to be in worship with us! Their presence is a joy to us. But we know that not all children can sit quietly through service, so we do have both a nursery and a training room. Our nursery is located in the last room on the left at the end of hallway. This separate space has the audio and video being streamed in for you while you change, nurse, or comfort your baby or toddler up to around 3 years old. Additionally, we have a training room located in the back of the auditorium. This space was designed as a refuge in which to train your young children to both sit quietly and participate as appropriate throughout the service.

Barrio Nuevo – Dave & Anne Bennett

Barrio Nuevo is a community development nonprofit embedded in under-resourced neighborhoods in South Phoenix. Our passion is to equip, mentor, and mobilize kids, teens, and older generations to transform our community from marginalization to holistic health and joy. We inspire our at-risk youth to become passionate about owning their life circumstances by developing as learners and leaders who make a difference in their families and communities.

About Dave & Anne - Both Dave and Anne attended Cal-Poly in San Luis Obispo, CA. Anne is a missionary kid (Pakistan) and also did a short term in Ethiopia. Both attended Westminster Seminary in Escondido, CA. They moved to Phoenix in 1994, and have mentored different church plants.

Transforming the Neighborhood – Some of the things Dave and Anne do as part of the Barrio Nuevo mission include

- Demonstrate a passion to follow Jesus' call to love the least, the lost and the last
- Tutor young people
- Partner with churches, schools and businesses to paint homes for low-income seniors
- Food distribution
