- 1) Have you been baptized in the name of the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit?
- 2) Have you publicly professed your faith in Jesus Christ, and do you embrace the Christian faith as summarized in the Apostles' Creed?
- 3) Are you presently a member in good standing of a Bible-believing, gospel-preaching church?

If you can affirm these questions sincerely, the elders welcome you to the Lord's Table! But if you have any hesitation at all, then we would encourage you to refrain from taking the Lord's Supper today. Reflect on the preached Word, Pray for God draw you closer to the Lord Jesus Christ, and come talk to the pastor or an elder.

How do I learn more about joining the church?

The Nursery & Training Room

We do not have a staffed nursery or separate children's ministry. Instead, we welcome your children to be in worship with us! Their presence is a joy to us. But we know that not all children can sit quietly through service, so we do have both a nursery and a training room. Our nursery is located in the last room on the left at the end of hallway. This separate space has the audio and video being streamed in for you while you change, nurse, or comfort your baby or toddler up to around 3 years old. Additionally, we have a training room located in the back of the auditorium. This space was designed as a refuge in which to train your young children to both sit quietly and participate as appropriate throughout the service.

Missionaries of the Month

DH and Emily Henry, MTW with the Navajo Nation

DH and Emily Henry serve with Mission to the World (MTW), the missions ministry of the PCA usually associated with international missions. However, the Henry's have been called to serve Christ by being missionaries to the Navajo Nation. In ministering to Native Americans, their call is not less cross-cultural than it would be if they had moved to the other side of the globe. The Henry family lives and ministers in Flagstaff, Arizona.

Prayer requests:

1. Please join us in praying for the development of a missionary couple/family or a single man to join us as a campus minister to the growing number of Indigenous college students at Northern Arizona University
2. DH Submitted a proposal to the session of Church of the Resurrection to begin a ministerial internship for Indian Bible College (IBC) students. Pray the God would use this for the development of a future Navajo church planting team.
3. Pray for the Henry children, Phineas, Josiah, Zoe, and Felicity, to receive the assessments, remediation, advocacy, and support they need to get the most out of their education while navigating the challenges of neurodiversity.
4. Pray for the preparations the Henrys need to make for their annual Christmas morning homeless outreach.

Jeff and Heather, MTW ministry to missionaries working in areas where the church is persecuted

Jeff and Heather have worked in areas of the world where it is not safe to be a Christian. They have been through many circumstances where they and their children have been in danger, and have suffered due to their calling as missionaries. More recently, they have taken on the roll of ministering to other missionaries who are in similar circumstances now.

1. Praise God for steadfastly loving and upholding Jeff and Heather and their family through so much and preserving their faith through it all!
2. Travel safety for both Jeff and Heather as they visit missionaries around the world to provide crisis counseling.
3. Continued healing for their daughter who is still dealing with the debilitating effects of a bacterial infection which left her unable to walk without assistance.
