Head Coverings -Not Cultural

Paul based his argument on:

Divine order (3)

Creation (8-9)

Angels (10)

Instinct (14-15)

"Head"

- Refers to <u>authority</u>, not source
- Jesus is "head over all things" (Eph 1:22)
- The metaphor derives from the human body
- The head rules over and directs the body

1 Corinthians 11:3

These examples establish the principle of order, headship and submission:

- Christ is head of every person (Mt 28:18; Heb 2:8; Phil 2:10-11)
- God is the head of Christ

Eternal (functional) Subordination of the Son (ESS)?

1 Cor 11:3

- This is Jesus <u>as the Christ</u>, subordinate to God in His work of redemption and restoration
- This subordination of Christ <u>apparently will end</u> when His work is finally complete (1 Cor 15:28)

1 Cor 11:3 Principle and Examples of Headship and Submission

Example 1

Christ is the head of every person

Principle

The man is the head of a woman

Example 2

God is the head of Christ

Don't allow these issues to cause contention or division in church

A woman should demonstrate by her femininity that she accepts the order God established at Creation

Women are not to have leading roles in the worship service

Wives asking husbands questions requires men to be pursuing an accurate understanding of God's Word



Women are not to have a leading or exhorting role in the assembly or wherever men are present
