Praise God the Spirit because...

- I. Prior to sealing you believed the gospel (13a).
- II. The Holy Spirit is the seal that secured you for God (13b-14b).
- III. You are kept secure until full redemption for God's glory (14b-c).

The Gospel Message

- God is holy

- Sin separates man from God
- Jesus died to pay man's penalty for sin
- Sinners must put their trust in Jesus' work to be delivered from sin and be reconciled to God

Seals were used to:

- ✓ 1) Indicate security
 - 2) Authenticate or certify
- 3) Identify ownership
 - 4) Indicate authority



God the Holy Spirit

He is the seal

He is holy

He is spirit

He was promised

He is our guarantee

"Pledge"



- *Earnest money put as a "down payment that was forfeited if the purchase was not completed" (Hoehner, *Ephesians*, p. 241)
- Served to guarantee that the rest of what was pledged would certainly follow
- The initial installment, part of the full payment

We are God's inheritance and He is ours

He will keep safe all those who bear His seal and He will do so until the day of our future redemption.

And those who bear His seal will certainly receive the fulness of their promised inheritance.
