Ephesians 4:11-12a Message Christ gives spiritually gifted people to His churches to equip all members to do the work of ministry.

The church leader is "one who helps and encourages all God's people to discover, develop and exercise their gifts...to enable the people of God to be a servant people, ministering actively but humbly according to their gifts in a world of alienation and pain"

# Exhortation to grow together toward unity of the faith (4:7-16)

- Christ gives spiritual gifts to each believer in the church (7-10)
- Some gifts equip believers to serve for growth, harmony and maturity (11-13)
- As believers serve one another, the result is stability, love and more growth (14-16)

Jesus gave certain gifts to equip the saints (11-12a)

#### Laid the foundation for the church (Eph 2:20)

#### Apostle

- Official delegate of Jesus Christ
- Delivered the gospel message and other NT truths
- Established and built up the earliest churches

Foundational Gifts

#### Laid the foundation for the church (Eph 2:20)

#### **Prophet**

- Received direct revelation of truth from God
  - Foretelling future events
  - Forthtelling (rebuke, call for repentance, encourage, comfort)
- God revealing truth through a spokesman

Foundational Gifts

#### **Evangelist**

- Sent out by a church
- Serve within a church
- Gifted at making the gospel message clear to unbelievers and are particularly effective in showing unbelievers their need of a Savior

Equipping Gifts

#### Pastor (shepherd)

- Leaders of people
- Leading
- Feeding
- Guarding
- Protecting
- Caring for the flock

Equipping Gifts

#### **Teacher**

- Explain and help apply Scripture
- Preaching
- Teaching SS or Bible studies
- Discipling
- Counseling

- Setting a broken bone
- Mending fishing nets
- Furnishing a room
- Evangelists, pastors and teachers equip all the saints to do the work of the ministry
