Ephesians 4:12b Message Christ gives gifts to His servant people, employing them all to do the work of ministry.

Equipping The Saints (Eph 4:11-13)

Jesus gave certain gifts to equip the saints (11-12a)

2

Jesus' initial goal was for the saints to do the work of ministry (12b)

"Service / Ministry"

- Related to the word for deacon
- Used to describe waiting tables, distributing food
- But can describe broader types of service (Acts 1:17, 25)
- Unique ministry assigned to each (Acts 20:24)
- Can be full-time or general (2 Tim 4:5; 2 Cor 5:18)

When we serve one another, we do work that is eternally significant

Helps / Service

- 1 Cor 12:5, 28; Rom 12:7; 1 Pet 4:11
- Faithful intercession
- Helper to a SS teacher
- Nursery or 2's and 3's
- Musical accompaniment in worship
- Office tasks
- Church library, literature racks
- Greeting and welcoming visitors
- Maintenance and repair
- Preparing the Lord's Supper
- Audio/visual ministries
- Helping missionaries

Administrations / Leading

- 1 Cor 12:28; Rom 12:8
- Piloting a ship, keeping it on course (Acts 27:11)
- Lead, supervise or manage diligently but as a servant, not lording over others
- God ordains some servants to lead other servants

The person with the gift of leading has "the ability to make wise decisions and to mobilize, motivate, and direct others toward an objective"

Administrations / Leading

- Elders lead
- Deacons oversee ministries
- Coordinators for:
 - Nursery
 - Missions
 - Mercy meals
 - SS teachers
 - Special occasions or events

Encouragement

- Rom 12:8
- To encourage, exhort, comfort or console
- Used in preaching, teaching, counseling, discipling
- Person-to-person words of encouragement
- Befriend lonely or outcast
- Come alongside those who need encouragement
- Words of compassion that seek to heal

Giving

God empowers some to give in special ways to meet the needs of the church and fellow members

- Rom 12:8
- Intensified form of "give"
- Give sacrificially, a giving of themselves
- "With liberality" =
 - Generosity (2 Cor 8:2-6)
 - Sincerity

Showing Mercy

- Rom 12:8
- Moved with compassion to do acts of mercy for those in need (Acts 9:36)
- Preparing meals
- Visiting and helping the sick, homebound or in nursing homes
- Helping in difficult situation
- Ministering to the poor or special needs

Hospitality?

- 1 Pet 4:9
- Good at providing a warm, loving environment
- Meals or lodging
- A place for warm fellowship
- Hosting missionaries and conference speakers
- Hosting gatherings
- Hosting a small group
