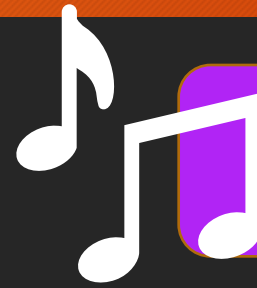

Other-centered ministries

Eph 5:19-21 - Be filled by the Spirit so you can...

- I. Purposefully communicate to educate and exhort one another (19a)
- II. Sing to the Lord Jesus from the heart (19b)
- III. Constantly give thanks to the Father for all that conforms to Jesus' mission (20)
- IV. Submit to one another in worshipful reverence of Christ (21)
