A Christian wife can be confident in submission knowing it is God's wise care for her

Notice Paul's reasoning in Eph 5:22-24

Wives submit to your own husbands (22)

Because God's original design points to and reflects Christ and His church (23)

Nevertheless, a submissive church is your model (24)

I. Wives submit to your own husbands (22)

Spirit-filled wives are responsible for submitting to their husbands out of wonder and awe toward Christ

Man's name (Adam) also name for mankind (adam)

God created Adam first (1 Tim 2:13) Adam responsible for giving God's instructions to Eve

Headship emphasizes responsibility to lead

Woman was made "for" the man

Woman was made "from" the man


The man named the woman

Her name ("ishah") was built from his name ("ish")

Evidences of male headship in Gen 1-2

"Head" (Eph 5:23)

- Greek kephale
- Normal usage: leader or authority
- Eph 1:22 and 4:15 Christ is head of the church, He leads it and has authority over it
- Describes lines of authority



"Savior of the body"

Leadership is other-focused, caring and compassionate toward those being led

A Christ-like leader is a self-sacrificing leader

Submission

John Stott explains that a wife's submission to her husband "is not to be an unthinking obedience to his rule but rather a grateful acceptance of his care"



A woman thrives within God's design when she rests in God's wisdom by joyfully submitting to her husband's leadership and care

Not if he forbids her doing what God commands

Not if he orders her to do what God forbids

If so, she must obey God and not her husband (Acts 5:39)

She is not called to give unconditional obedience to her husband

She is accountable to God to not sin
