

- blessed
- hope is in the LORD
- like a tree by waters
- doesn't fear when heat comes
- green, bears fruit
- (his fruitfulness is a help to others)

Deceitful:

Your Heart is out to trick you
Your Heart is cunning and treacherous
You can't trust your heart

"Follow your heart"

- sure, straight to destruction

Above all things – totally Every part is affected

Deceitful

Desperately wicked: it's incurable

Who can know it?

- 2. He gives us the fruit of our ways, not of what we think about ourselves or get others to think about us. We get just what we deserve from Him. It's like a teacher, giving the grades.

Jeremiah prays for personal deliverance

- Verses 14-18
- He knows that if he is to be saved, God has to do it.

Jeremiah pointed to

- 1. his dependence on God for healing and salvation
- 2. his faithfulness to his ministry
- 3. the fact that he did not desire the evil that was coming
- 4. the fruit of his lips
- 5. the fact that he was seeking God for refuge from a deserved destruction

Blessings for heeding God.


- 1. The good blessings of God would continue v 25
- 2. God would be praised. v 26


THE SABBATH TEST

The Grading
Failing grade verse 27
Curses for not heeding God
1. Destruction of the things God had given them

2. No end to the destruction.

(Note: They failed the test.)





It represents a finished work

Six days you shall labor, and do all your work, but the seventh day is a Sabbath to the LORD your God. On it you shall not do any work, ... For in six days the LORD made heaven and earth, the sea, and all that is in them, and rested on the seventh day.

Therefore the LORD blessed the Sabbath day and made it holy.

Exodus 20:9-11

It represents freedom from slavery

Observe the Sabbath day, to keep it holy, as the LORD your God commanded you. Six days you shall labor and do all your work, but the seventh day is a Sabbath to the LORD your God. On it you shall not do any work, ...

You shall remember that you were a slave in the land of Egypt, and the LORD your God brought you out from there with a mighty hand and an outstretched arm. Therefore the LORD your God commanded you to keep the Sabbath day.

Deuteronomy 5:12-15

It represents atonement from sin

For on this day shall atonement be made for you to cleanse you. You shall be clean before the LORD from all your sins.

It is a Sabbath of solemn rest to you, and you shall afflict yourselves; it is a statute forever.

Leviticus 16:30-31

It represents the Lord's sanctifying

Speak to the people of Israel and say,
'Above all you shall keep my Sabbaths,
for this is a sign between me and you
throughout your generations, that you may
know that I, the LORD, sanctify you.'

Exodus 31:13

It represents a perpetual covenant

Wherefore the children of Israel shall keep the sabbath, to observe the sabbath throughout their generations, for a perpetual covenant.

It is a sign between me and the children of Israel for ever: ...

Exodus 31:16-17

Therefore let no one pass judgment on you in questions of food and drink, or with regard to a festival or a new moon or a Sabbath.

These are a shadow of the things to come, but the substance belongs to Christ.

Colossians 2:16-17

THE SABBATH A FULFILLED FORESHADOWING

It represents a finished work

So then, there remains a Sabbath rest for the people of God,

for whoever has entered God's rest has also rested from his works as God did from his.

Let us therefore strive to enter that rest, ...
