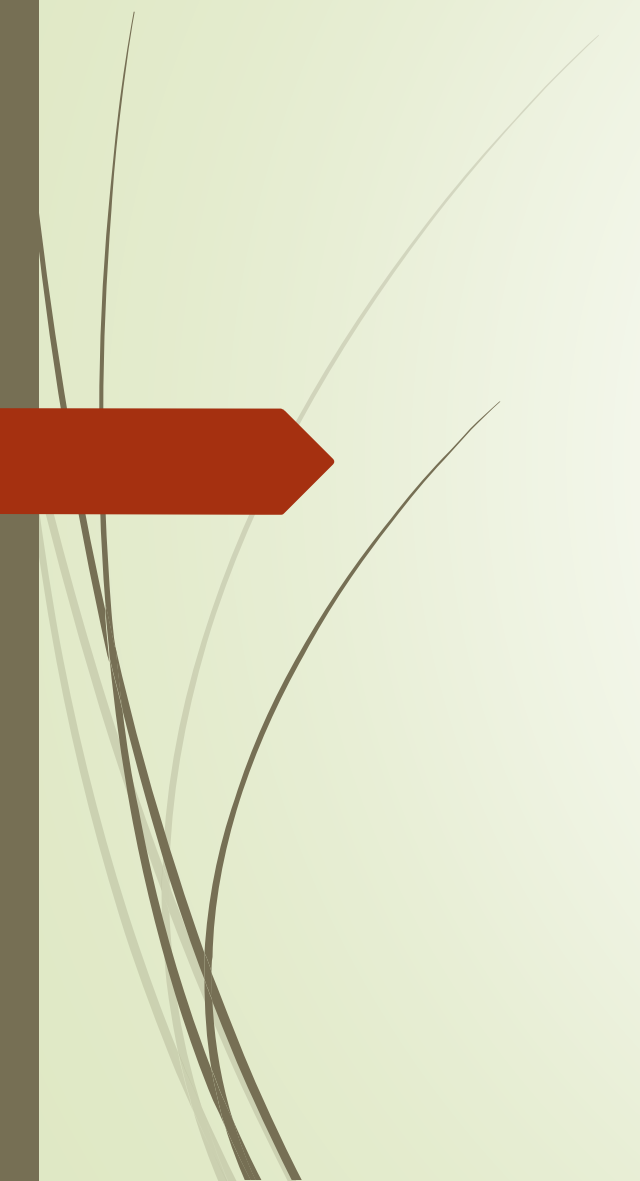
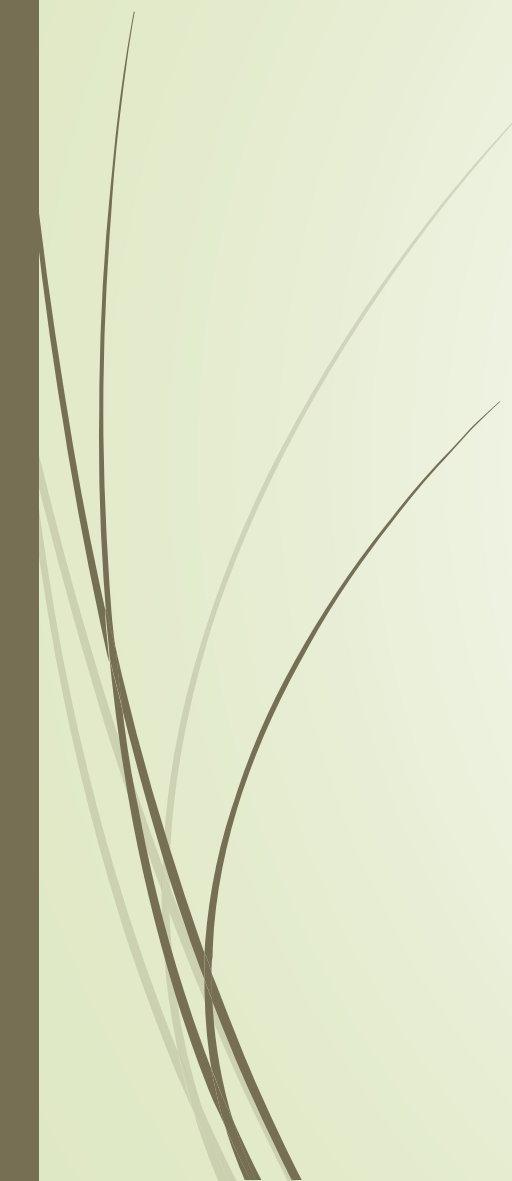

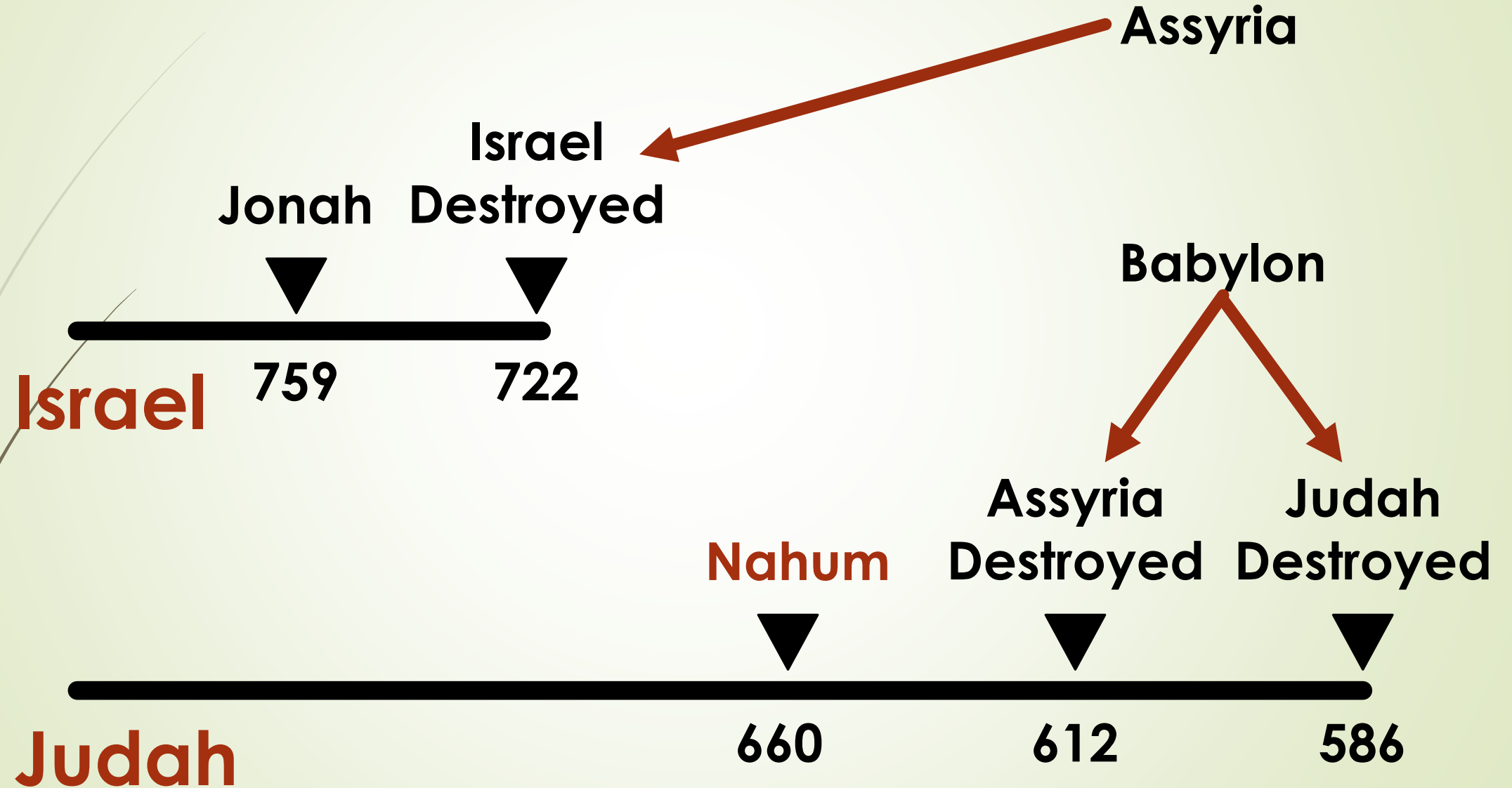
Yahweh alone has the power and the character to make all things right and works in history to give His people sturdy hope.

Nahum Timeline



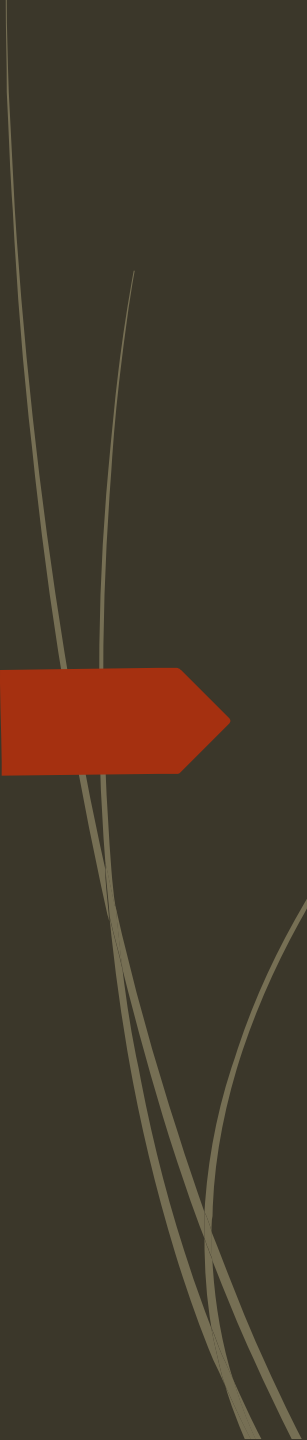
