

### SOLUTION: OLD TO NEW

- Rom 8:23 Our current body will be redeemed, glorified
- 1 Cor 15:36ff Illustration of a seed
  - The seed dies producing a new plant
  - There is continuity, but also profound change
  - Our body will be "sown" then "raised"
  - So heaven and earth will pass away but produce a new heaven and earth
