Proverbs - Purpose

Proverbs was written:

- ✓ to educate God's people on the nature of biblical wisdom,
- ✓ to instruct them on the quest for wisdom
- ✓ and to orient them to the proper foundation for wisdom

- 4) Instructors, give wisdom so the simple become shrewd or clever (4a)

Simple – gullible, naïve Prudence – shrewd, clever

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- 5) Instructors, give the youth knowledge to help them think for themselves (4b)

Youth — not yet considered an "elder"

A wise son	A foolish son
Makes	Is
Glad	A grief to
A father	His mother

Diagram of Proverbs 10:1

Line 1	Line 2	Lessons
A wise son	A foolish son	Same child can choose either path
Makes	Is	"Makes" = real impact; "Is" = impact ongoing
Glad	A grief to	Significant impact on parent's emotions
A father	His mother	Child's attitude affects both parents
