- 1. Focus on wisdom with its glorious benefits (1-2)
- II. This wisdom is tried and true (3-9)

- A. Your grandfather passed it down to me (3-4a)
- B. His appeal: Acquire wisdom to really live (4b-6)
- C. His explanation: Start by giving everything to buy it (7)
- D. His motivation: Your wisdom will radiate with God's favor (8-9)




