Proverbs 6:20-35

- I. Devote yourself to Lady Wisdom's shepherding light (20-24)
 - A. Be attentive to your parents' teaching (20-21)
 - B. Like a shepherd, Lady Wisdom guides and protects (22-24)

- II. Lady Wisdom's light can protect you from making a miserable exchange (25-35)
 - A. You're in danger of exchanging your life for temporary pleasure (25-26)

Proverbs 6:22 and Deut 6:7

Children learn God's wisdom in all of life's contexts so it can protect them in all of life's contexts

Parents "teach them [God's ways] diligently to your sons and shall speak of them when you sit in your house and when you walk by the way and when you lie down and when you rise up" (Dt 6:7)

"When you walk about, she [wisdom] will lead you; when you sleep, she will keep watch over you; and when you awake, she will speak to you" (Prov 6:22)

Proverbs 6:22

Speak

- Speak describes "loud, enthusiastic, emotionally laden speech" (Bruce Waltke, Proverbs, I:352)
- The idea is that of meditation on God's word (Derek Kidner)



Teaching: God's and Parents'

"Your word is a **lamp** to my feet and a **light** to my path" (Ps 119:105)

"The commandment of your father...is a lamp"

"The law of your mother...is **light**" (Prov 6:20, 23; Deut 6:7)
