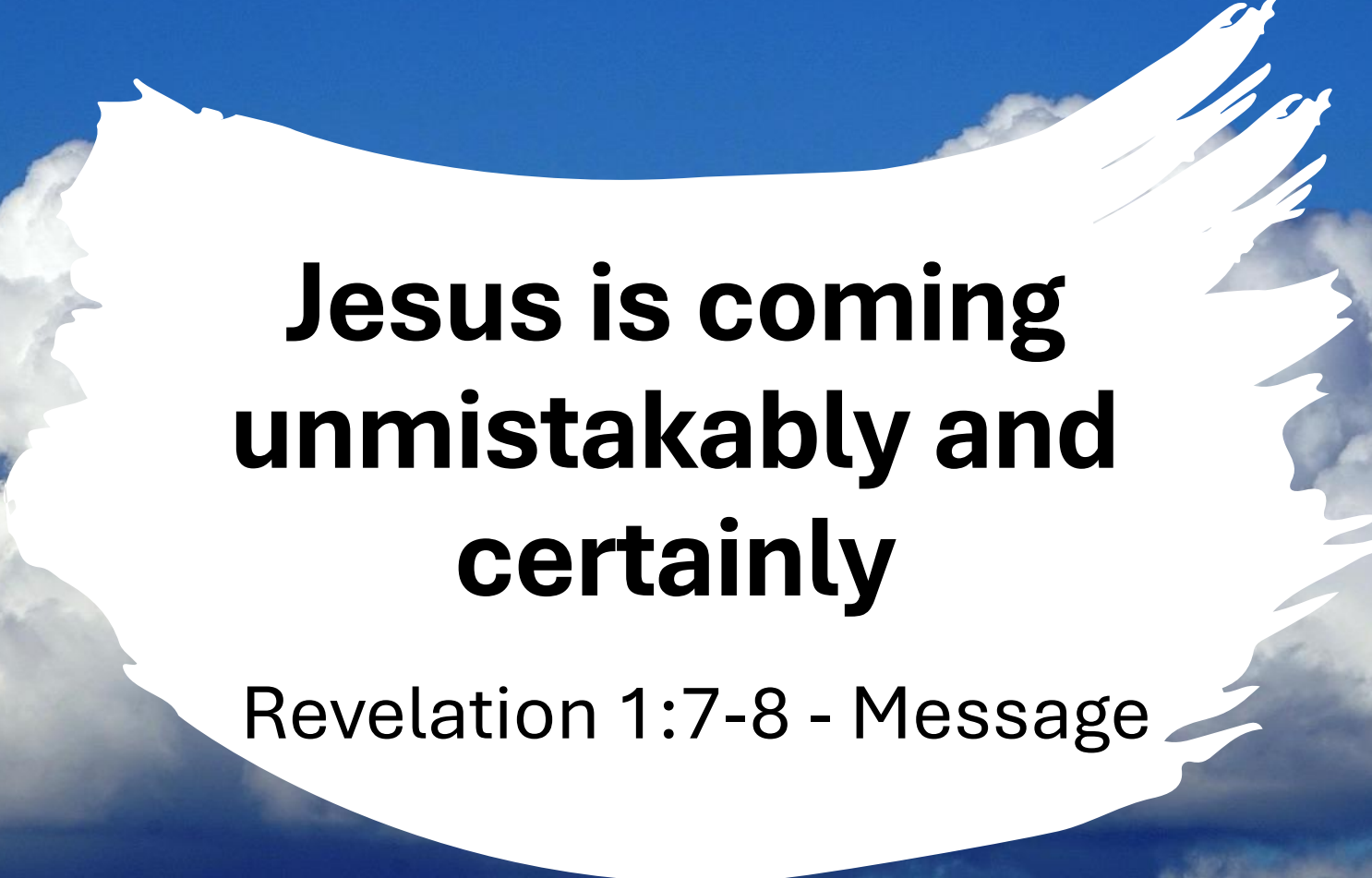

unmistakably and
certainly**

Revelation 1:7-8 - Message

Unmistakably

- I. Jesus is coming triumphantly, visibly, and evoking worldwide response
 - A. He is coming triumphantly from heaven
 - B. His coming will be visible worldwide
 - C. His coming will bring mourning worldwide

Certainly

- II. His Father verbally attests to its certainty
 - A. He is self-existent
 - B. He is eternal
 - C. He is omnipotent

Revelation 1:7-8 – Jesus is coming!

Dan 7:13 & Rev 1:7

Clouds – Meaning

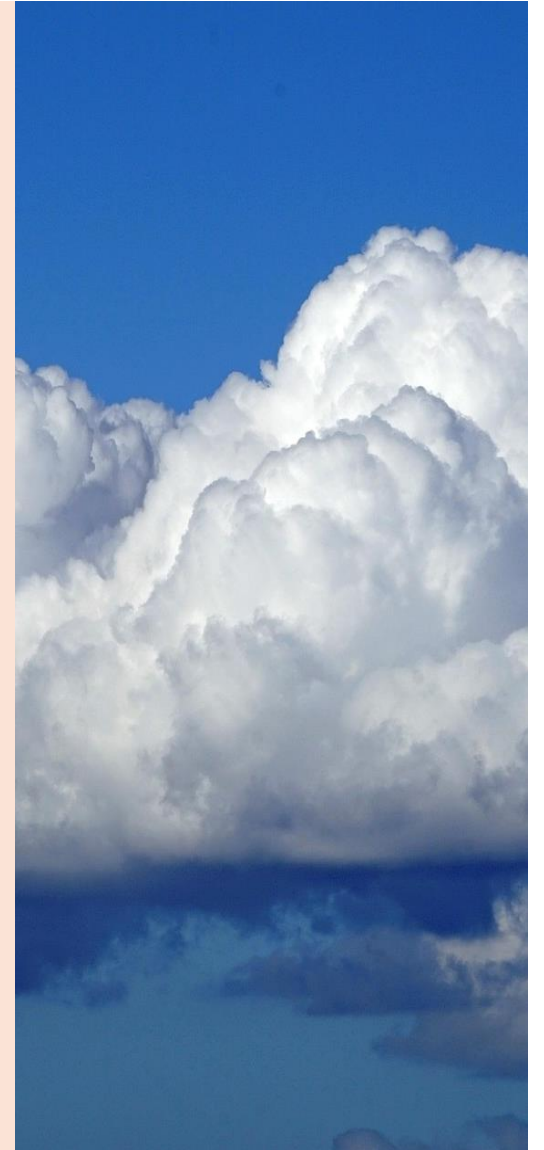
God's presence – primary (Ex 13:21; 19:9; 34:5)

God's movement – sometimes (Ps 104:3; Isa 19:1)

God's judgment – sometimes (Isa 19:1)

Jesus & clouds – not always judgment

- Approaching the Ancient of Days (Dan 7:13)
- Transfiguration (Mt 6:28-7:8)
- Ascension (Acts 1:9)
- Second Coming (1 Thess 4:16-17)





Zechariah 12:10 - Context

The context of Zech 12 looks “to the end-time period when God will defeat the enemy nations around Israel and the Israelites will be redeemed after repenting of their sinful rejection of God and his messenger [Messiah]”

Jesus' return will provoke a response of mourning

- Mourn while suffering God's **judgment** (Mt 24:30)
 - Mourn in **repentance** (Zech 12:9-13:1, 9)
 - Some mourn under **judgment**, others mourn in **repentance** “over Him” (Rev 1:7)
