

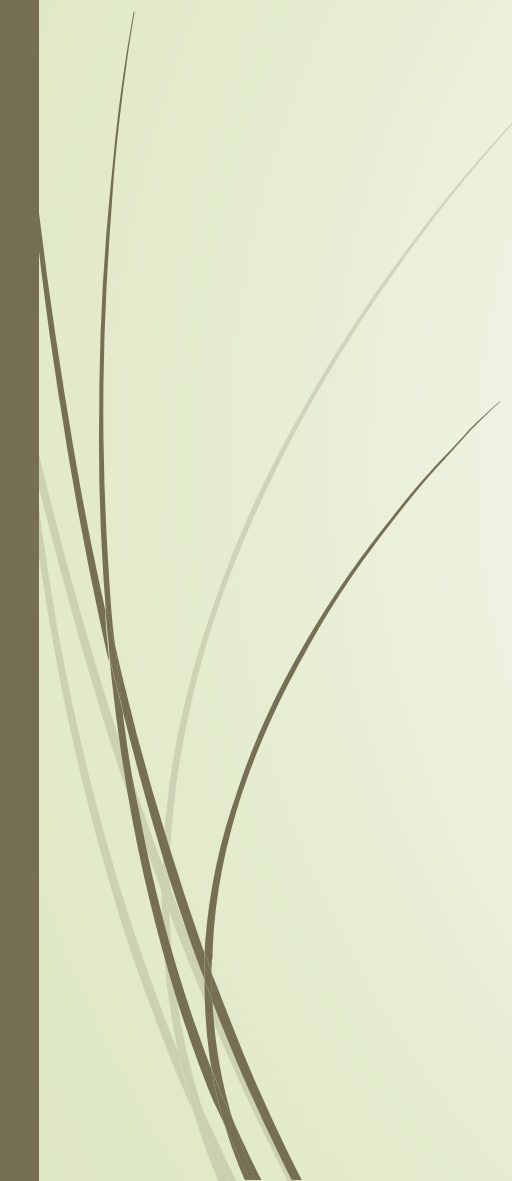

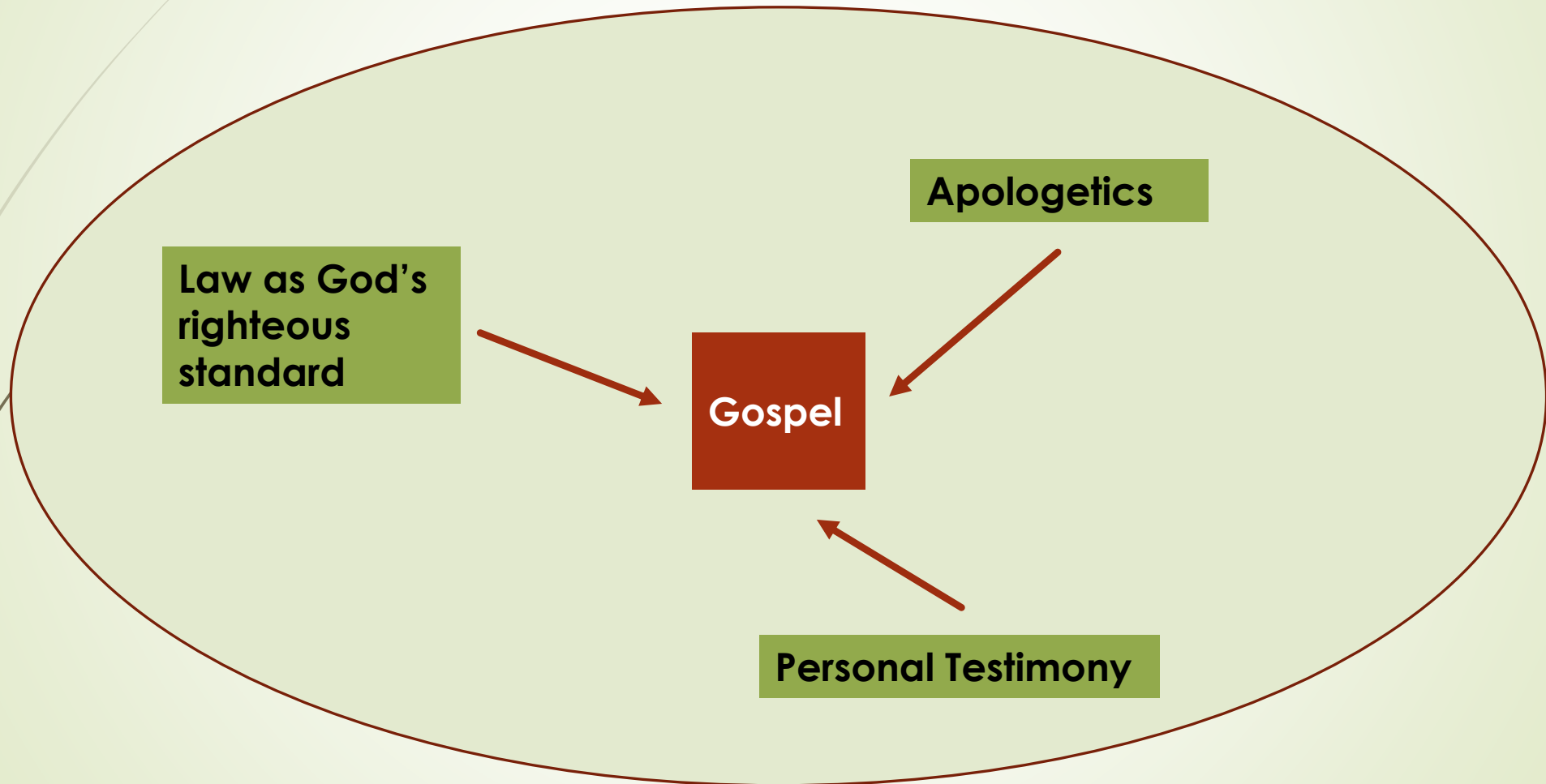

“a man is justified by faith apart from works of the Law...God reckons righteousness apart from works” – Rom 3:28; 4:10
