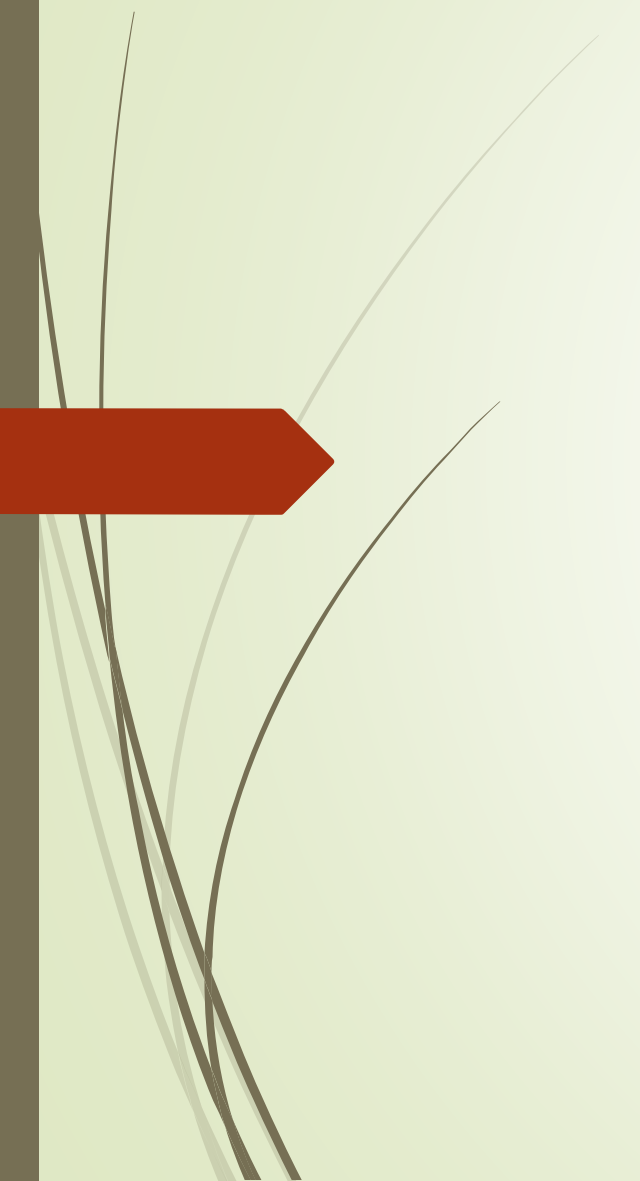

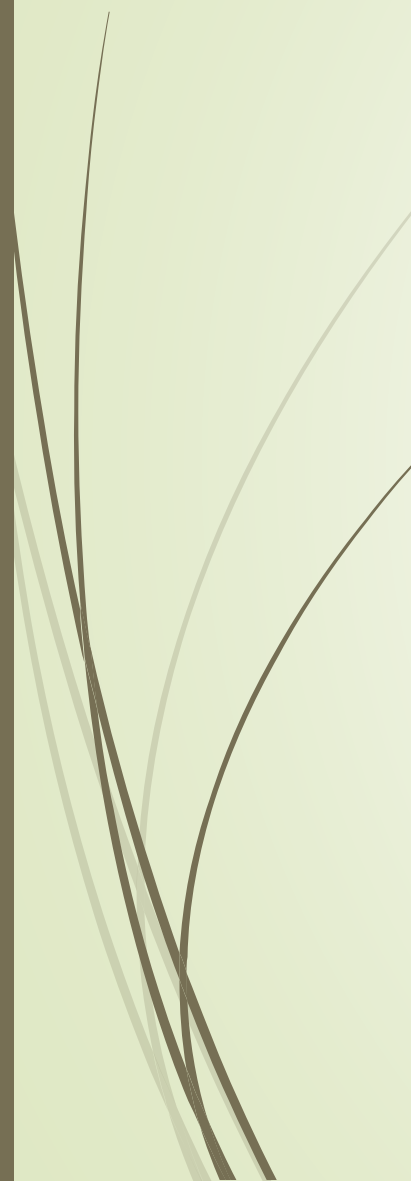

Vision 7: Woman in an ephah (5:5-11)

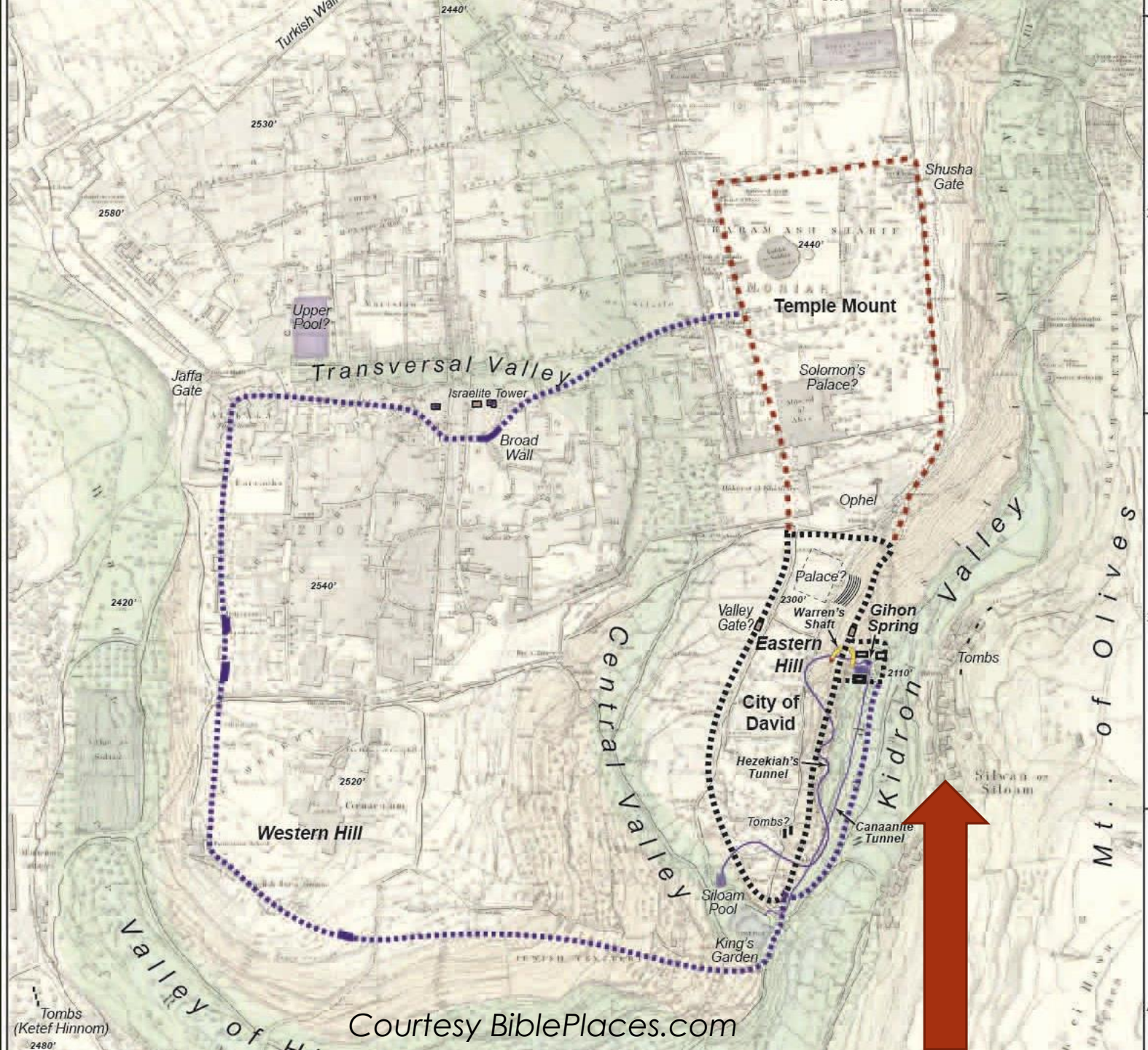
**Wickedness will be removed from
