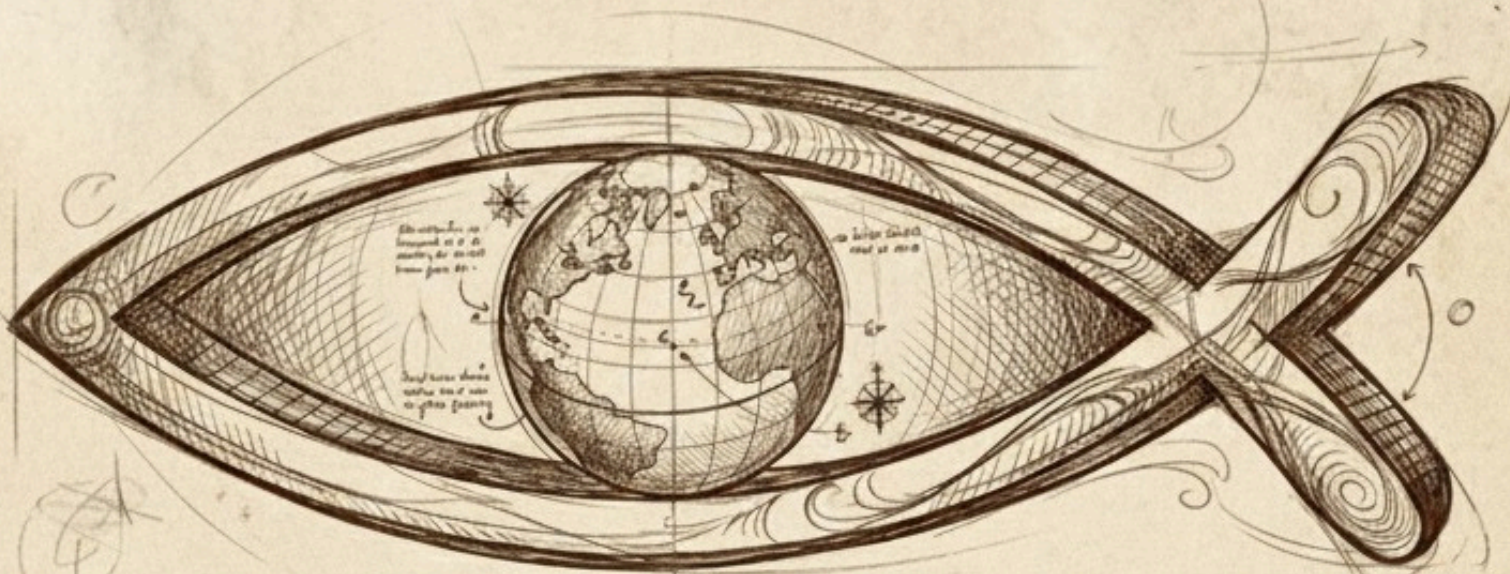

# OTHER IMPORTANT INFO

## ✓ **What to bring**

BRING money to give to ACT NOW & the Resource Center, your Bible, a sleeping bag, a pillow, towels, toiletries, and warm clothes. Also, bring a 2 liter of soda and a snack to share with everyone.

*Please pack a pair of clothes you are able to get dirty!*

✗ **DON'T BRING** tobacco, computers, drugs, alcohol, firearms, fireworks, knives...you get the idea. When in doubt, ask a leader. Please leave your pranks at home! Pranks and practical jokes can be a distraction & a temptation to others. Let's focus on encouraging each other instead.





Check-in opens on Friday, March 6th at 5:30 pm. Please do not come early... we have lots to do to prepare for you! Dinner will not be served, so eat something before you get there!

- Drivers should drop off everyone in their car at the NorthBay welcome area and then drive back to the upper parking lot. We will provide a conference shuttle service (vehicles with yellow flashing lights) that will bring drivers back to the main entrance, where the driver can rejoin his/her party at check-in.
- Our Welcome Team will direct you to the dining hall (Blackbeard's), where you will check in for the conference and receive all your Momentum Conference info & materials. They will be glad to help you if you have any questions!
- Check-in closes at 7:00 pm on Friday evening. Anyone arriving after 7:00 should go directly to the Turkey Point Theater for the main session and return to the dining hall for late check-in after the Friday night session

# Directions To NorthBay

\*NOTE: There is an \$8 toll charge on the way to NorthBay

From the Baltimore area, take I-95 North to exit 100, MD-272-  
(sign will say North East / Rising Sun)

Keep right (south toward North East) at the fork in the ramp  
to merge onto MD-272 south and go 10.5 miles.

Look for the NorthBay sign and turn right off MD-272 into the  
NorthBay property on Horseshoe Point Lane. Proceed on the  
driveway and down the big hill until you arrive at the circle.  
Drivers, drop off your passengers and bags and return to the  
top of the hill to park. A shuttle will drive you back down to rejoin  
your party.
