Q: How has God most clearly revealed Himself to mankind?

Big Idea: God has spoken supremely through the Son, Jesus Christ

The Engaging Introduction - Words that begin with the letter π (v. 1)

1. Jesus is the eternal Word who created the world (v. 2)

2. Jesus is the revealed Son who sustains the creation (v. 3a)

3. Jesus is the sacrificial lamb who is to receive the glory forever (vv. 3b-4)
