Q: What is the purpose of the declared judgment against the failed kings of Judah?

Big Idea: All earthly kings will let you down, but Christ the only righteous King will never let you down.

1. God’s Standard for a King (22:1-5)

A king’s role is to execute justice with moral righteousness

2. The Chronicles of Failed Kings (21:3-7)

Kings who first seek security over God will be condemned

- a. Zedekiah (21:3-7)
- b. Jehoahaz – “Shallum” (22:10-12)
- c. Jehoiakim (22:13-19)
- d. Jehoiachin – “Coniah” (22:24-30)

3. The Righteous King Prophesied (23:1-8)

The only king who can meet God’s standards is King Jesus
