Q: Who will bring to account all the evil acts of man and nations?

Big Idea: Yahweh is the sovereign judge whose justice has been fulfilled and will be fulfilled

Theological Principles from Jeremiah 46-52

1. God is just (chs. 46-52)

God judges every evil act of every person and nation both great and small

2. God is sovereign (51:49)

God uses even evil nations to punish the sins of other nations

3. God is gracious (46:27-28, 49:39, 52:31-34)

God seeks sinners' repentance and salvation over death

4. God is real (ch. 52)

God's glory will be fully revealed and his servants vindicated in Christ's return
