2. In verses 7-11, list Peter's examples of what redemptive love looks like in practice. For each, what reason does Peter give for why he includes it? How does each relate to the others? How would this benefit suffering people?

3. How does the fact of Christ's return keep you sane and sober in difficult situations?
4. What gifts do you have? How are you using them now? What reflections do you have on why and how you might use them in the future?
