Psalm 19: "God's Glory in Creation"

Ice Breaker: What's the best honey you have ever tasted? How best do you like to eat honey?

Dig:

1. Who "speaks" in vv1-6? What can we learn about God from each of their voices?
2. In vv7-13, what words does David use to describe God's law? How does David describe its effect on our lives?
3. Note that David uses the name "El" for God in v1, then switches to "Yahweh" in vv7-9. Why the change? Compare and contrast God's revelation through creation (Question #1) with his revelation through scripture (Question #2). What implications does this have for us regarding the gospel?

Apply:

4. What in creation fills you most with a sense of God's glory? Reflect on that "voice" during your next personal prayer-time with God.
5. Which of David's descriptions of scripture is most meaningful to you? Reflect on that "picture" during your next personal meditation-time with God.
